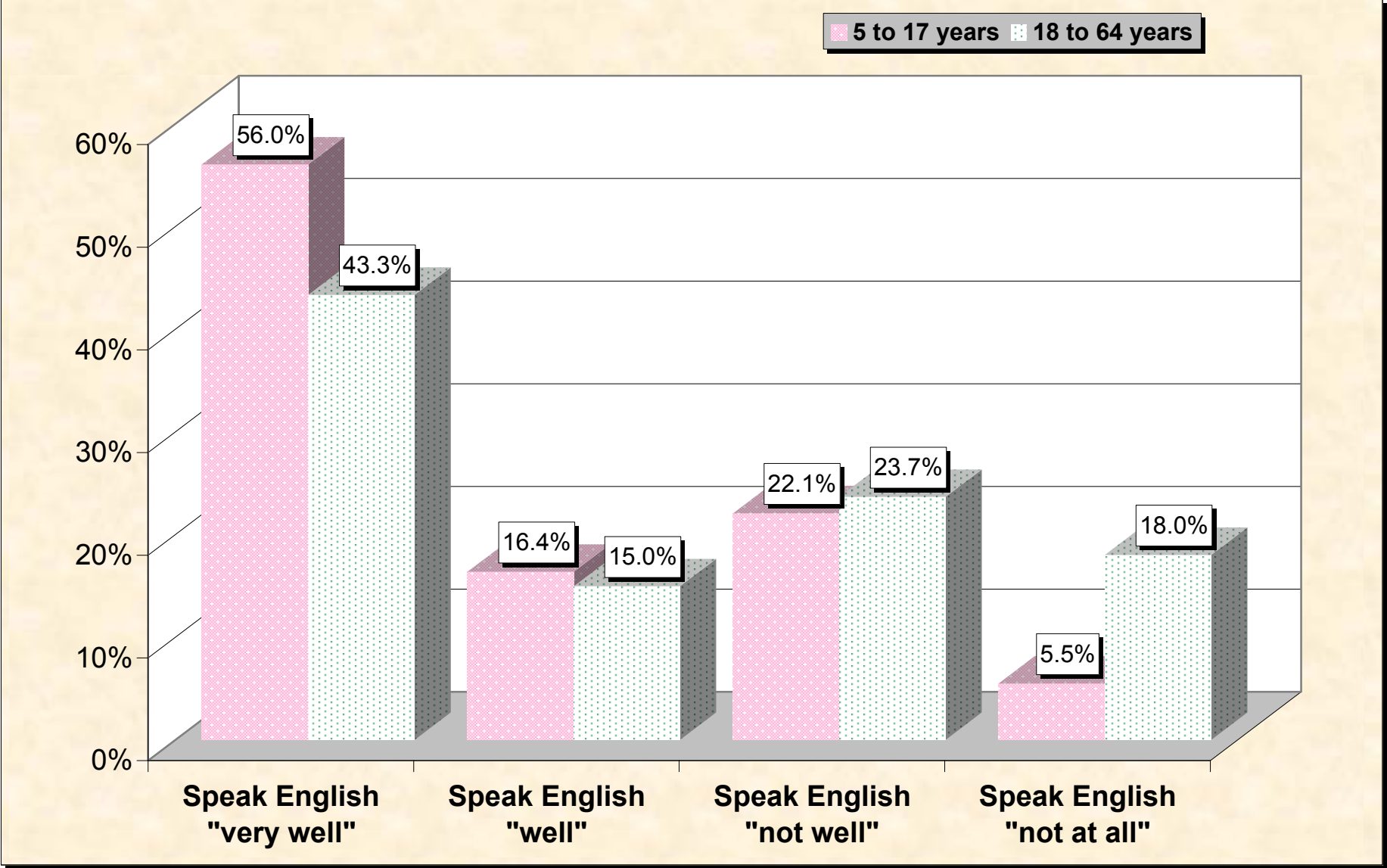

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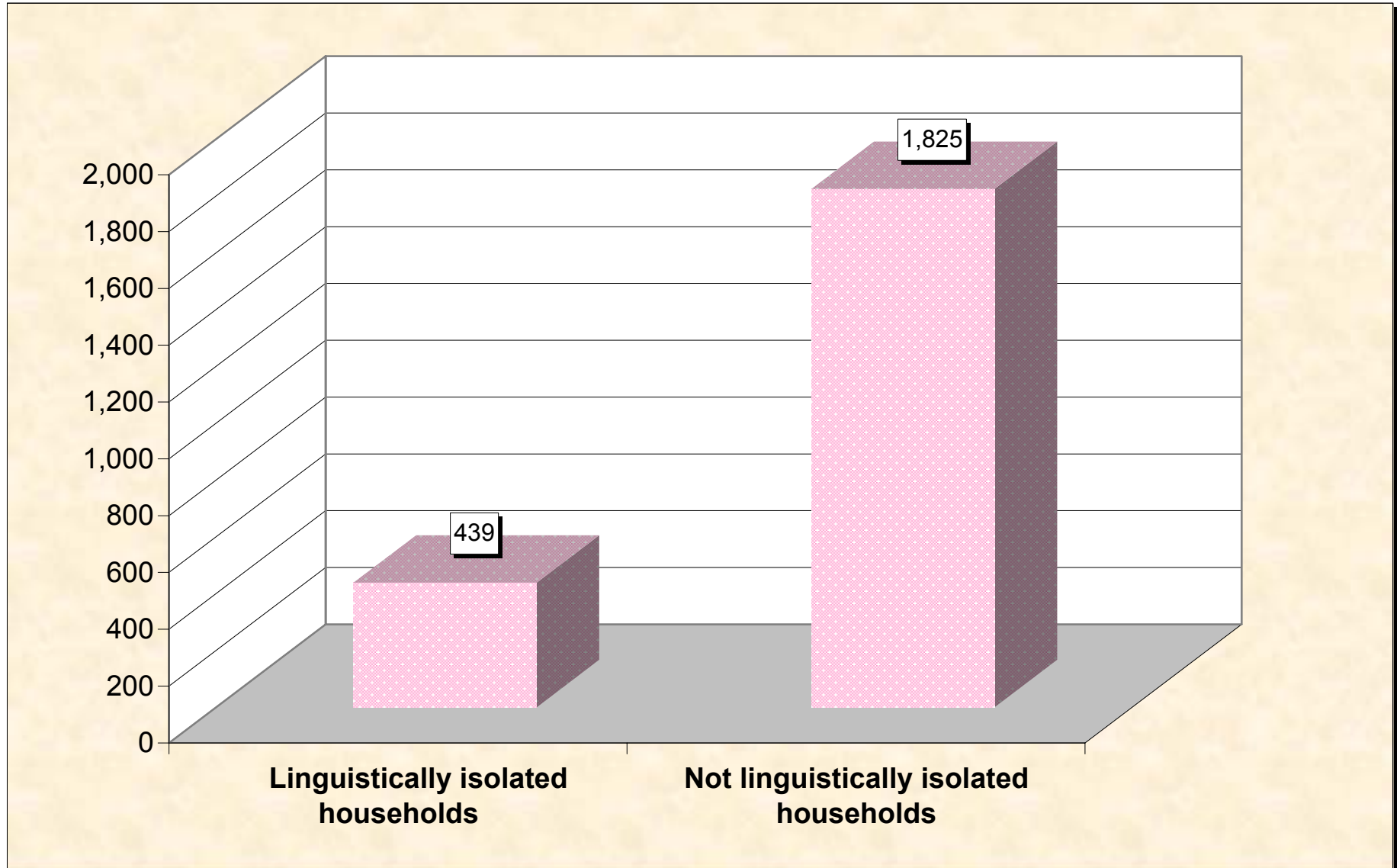
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Chart 1 -- English Proficiency by Age for Persons who Speak Spanish at Home Pitt County, North Carolina
