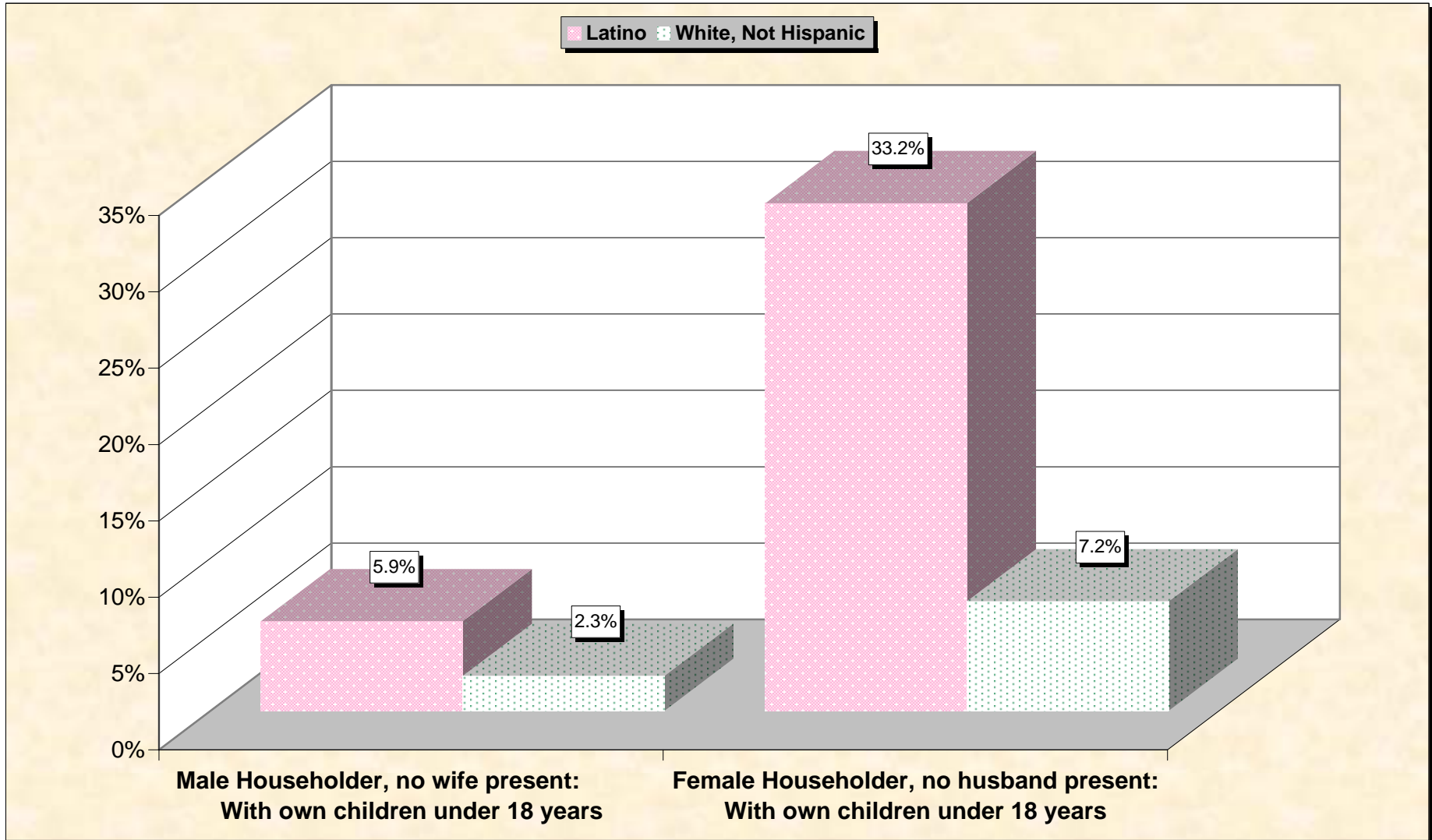

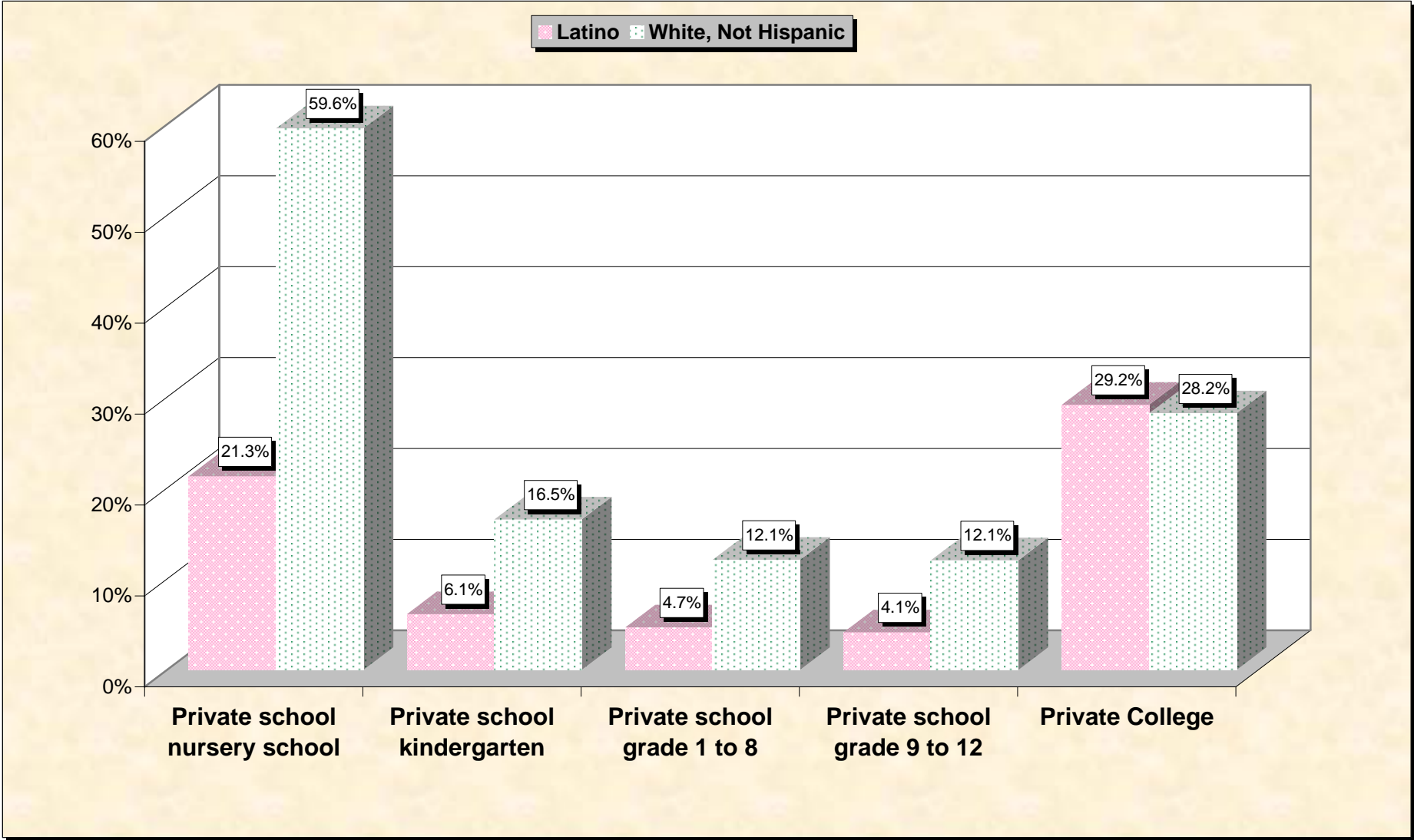

Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



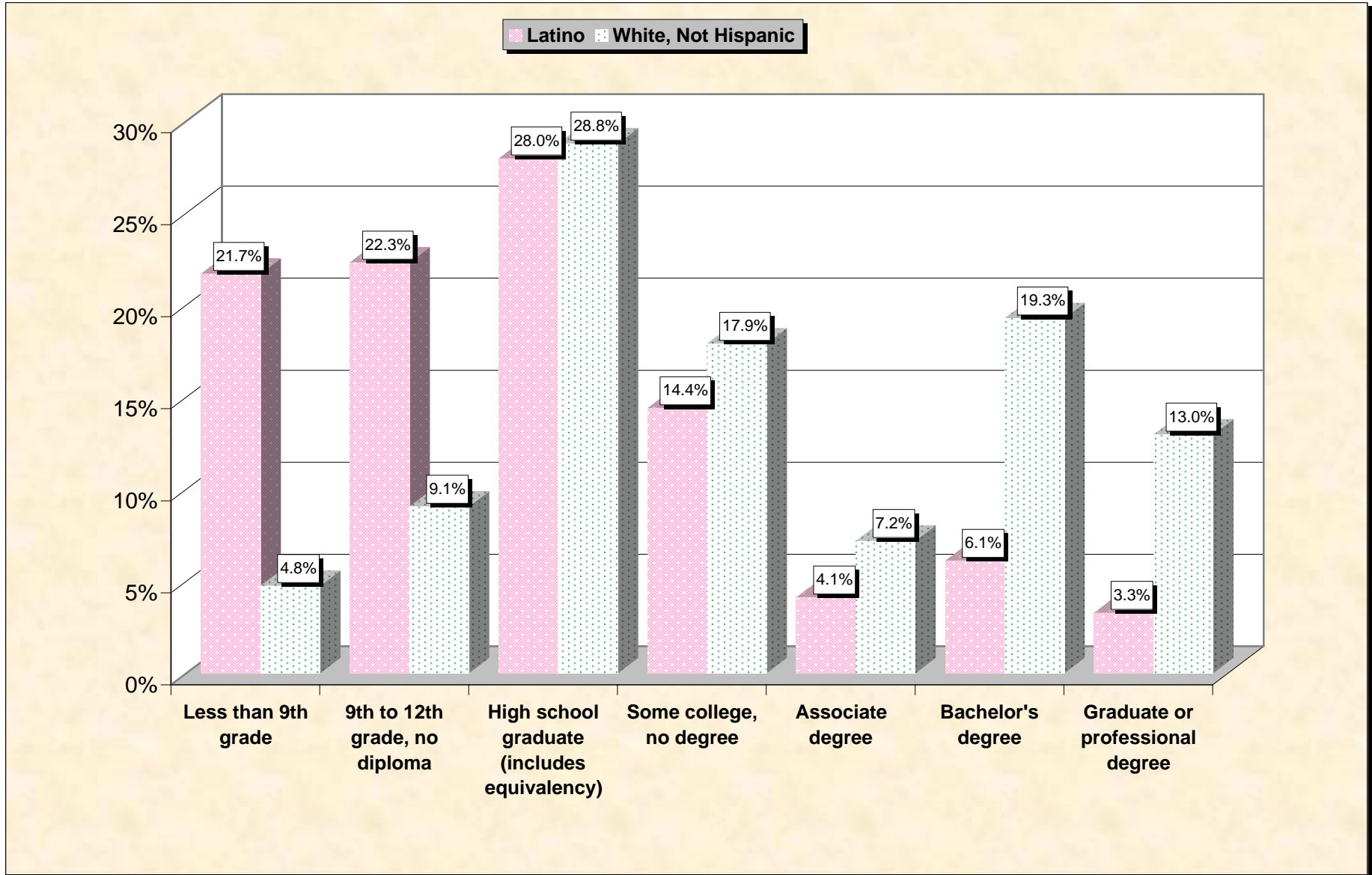

Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



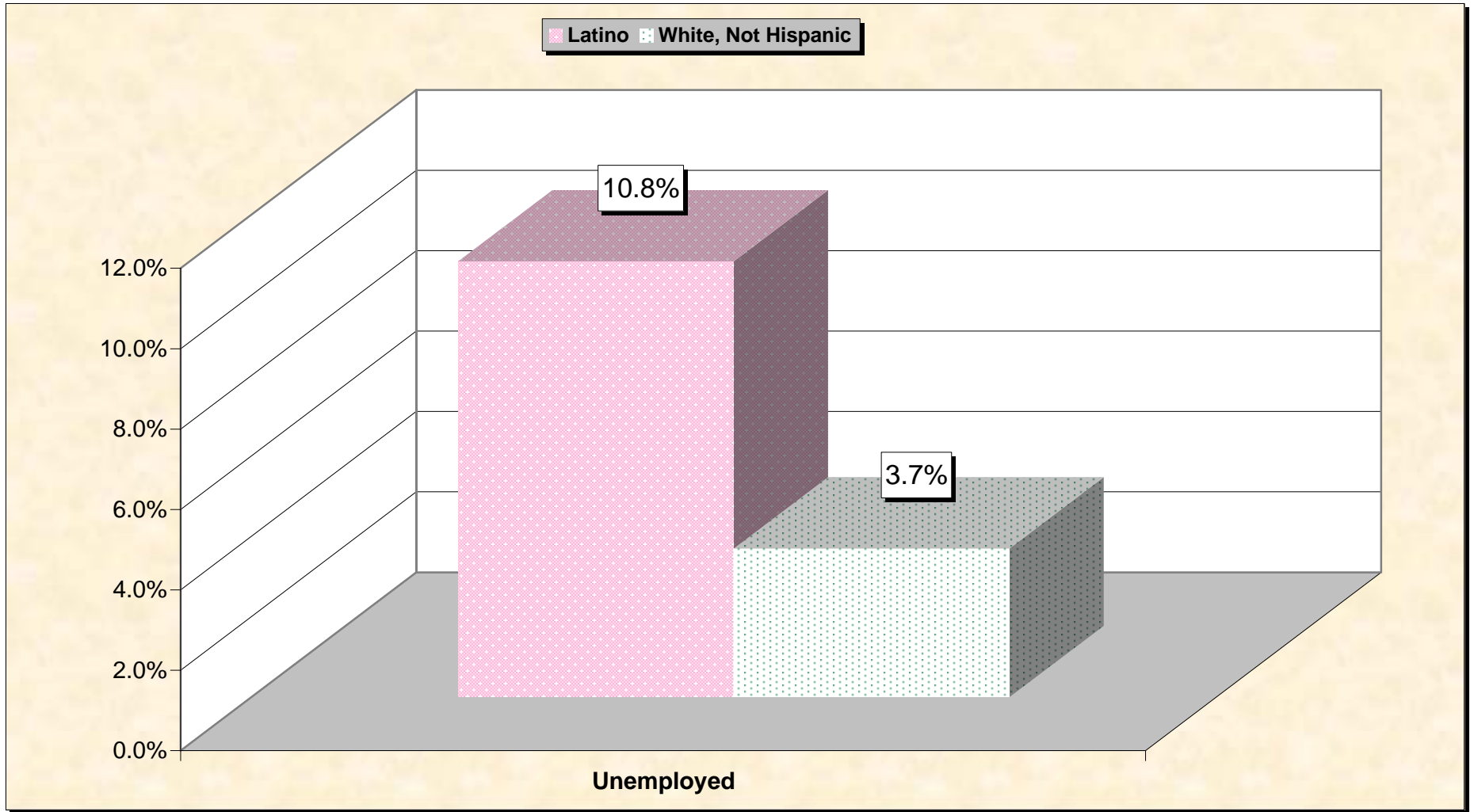

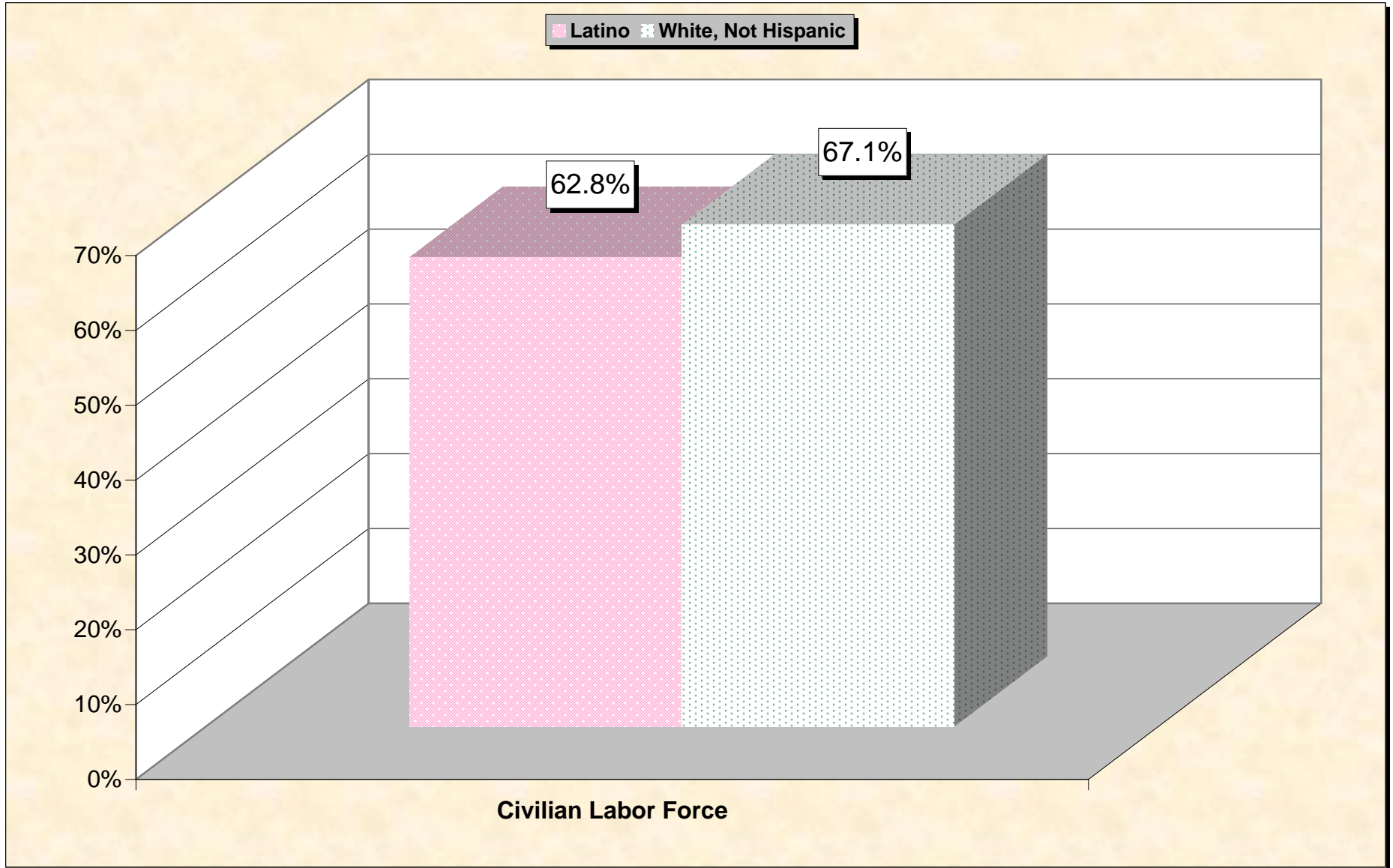
Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut

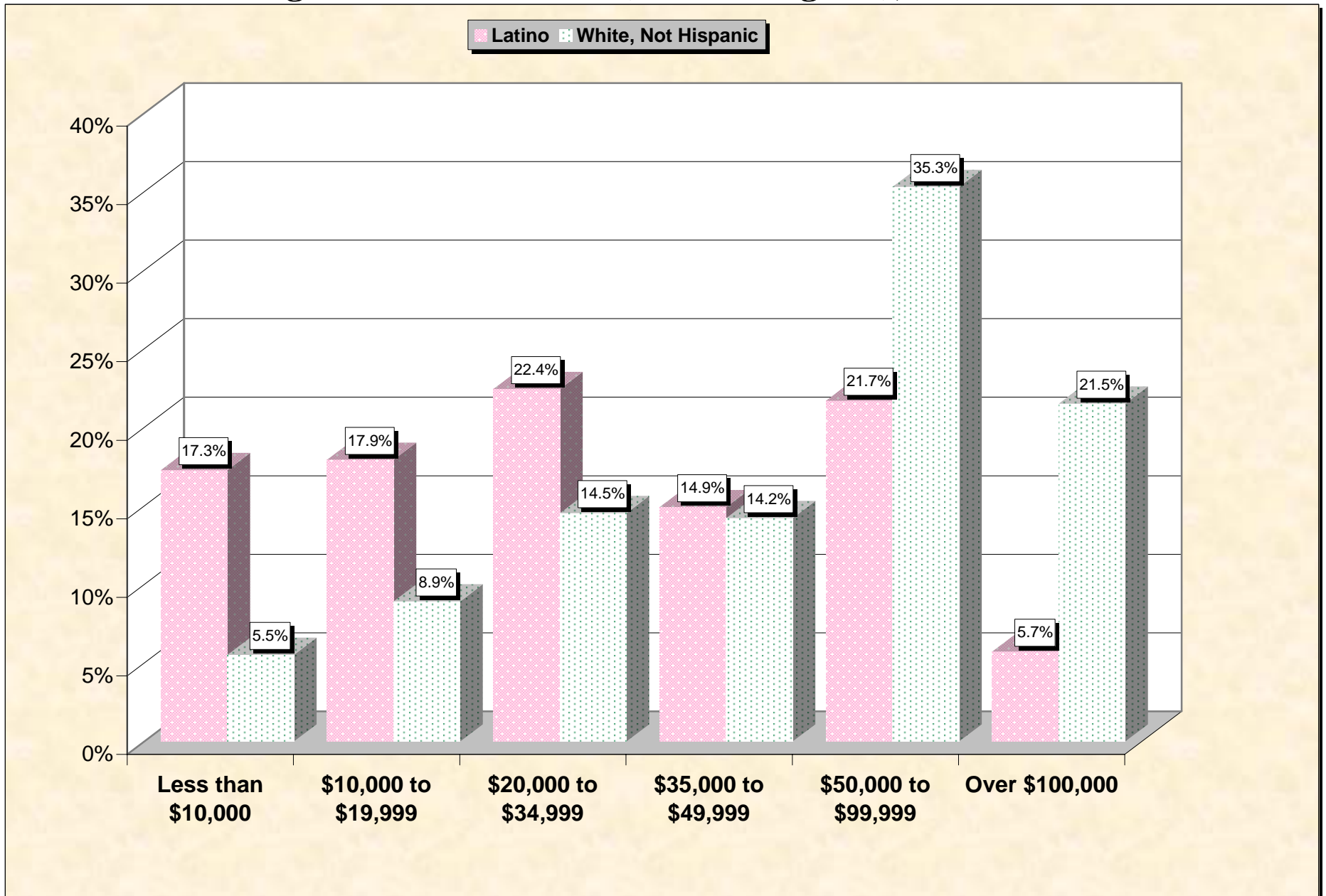
Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut

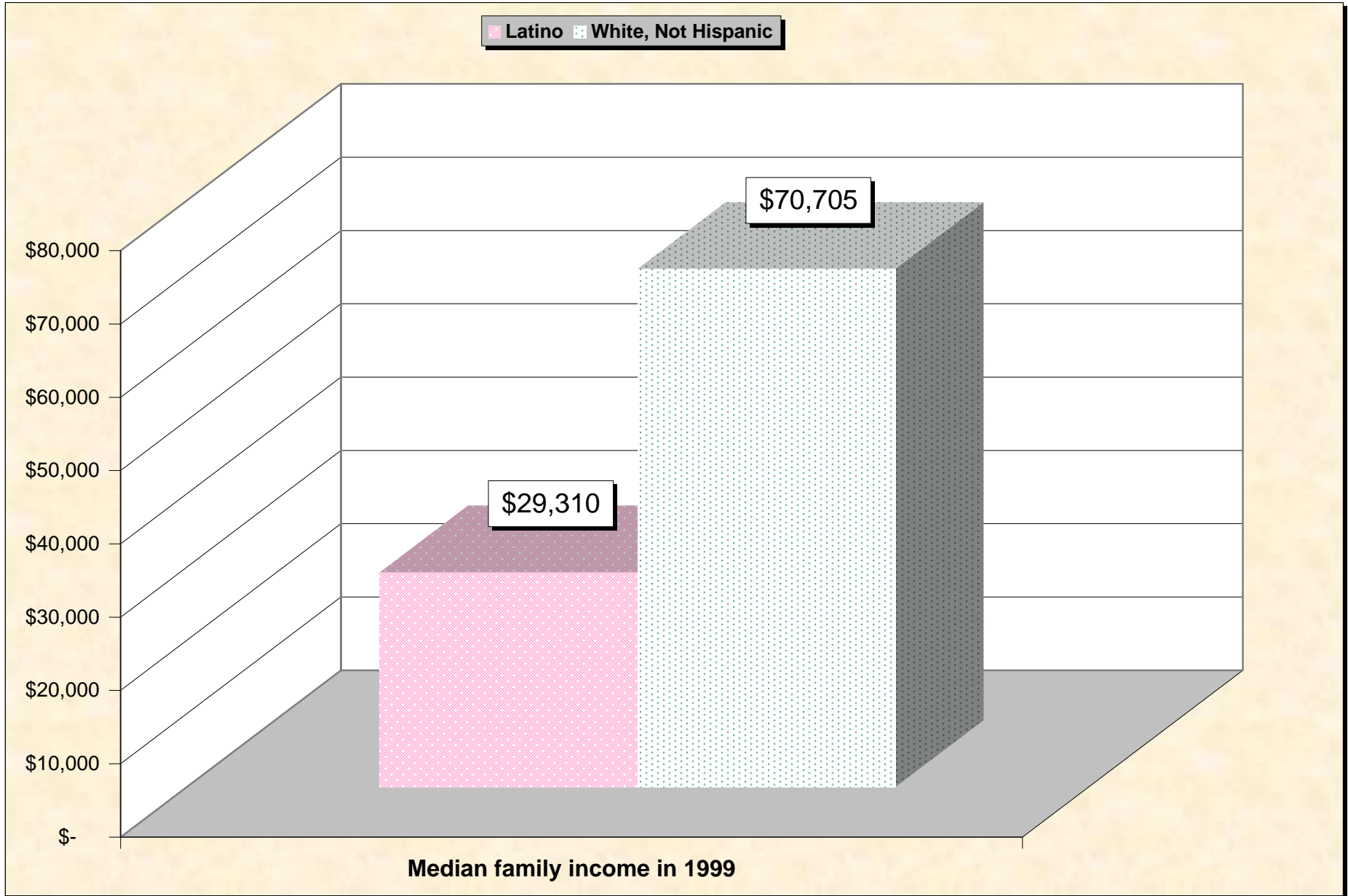

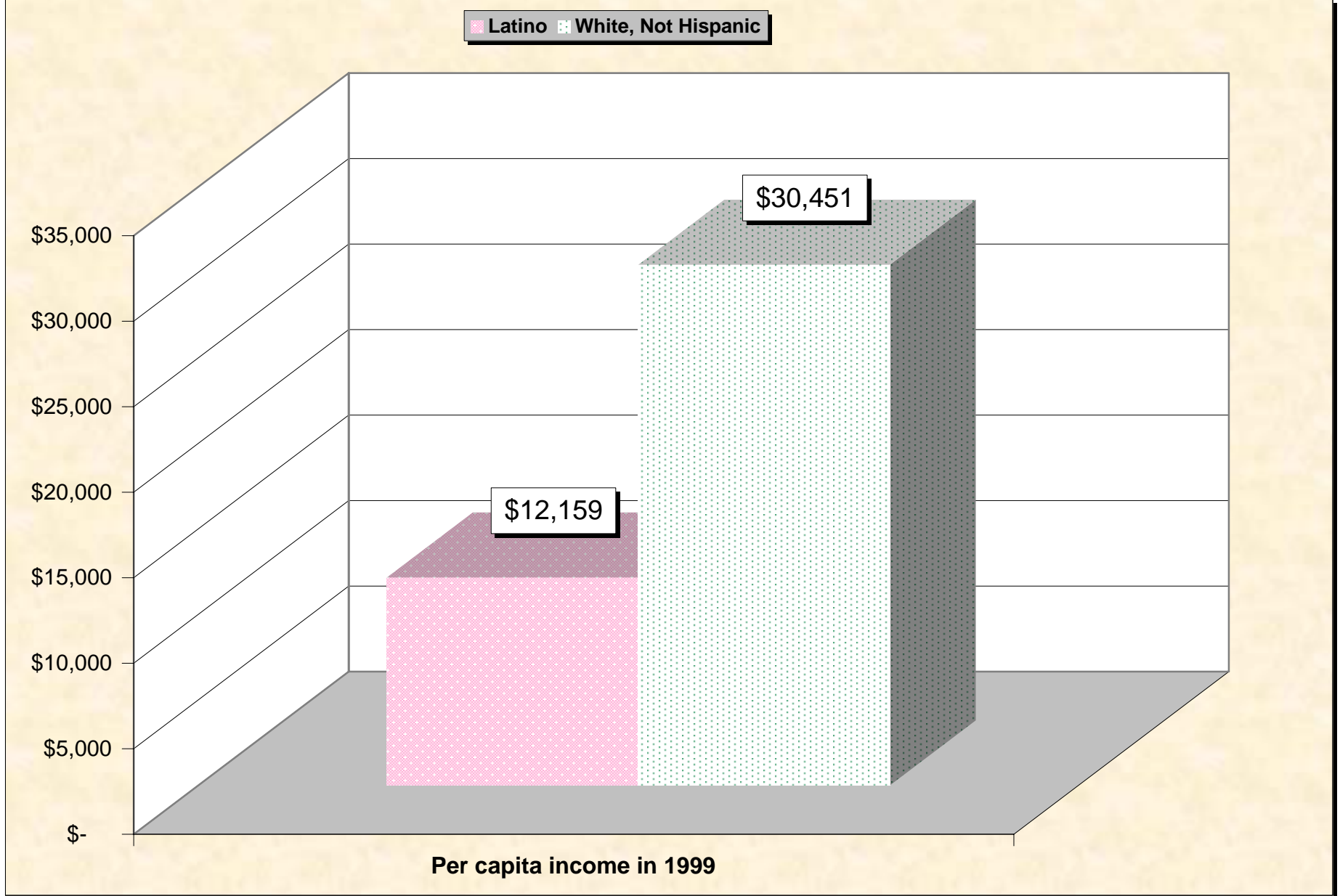
Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut

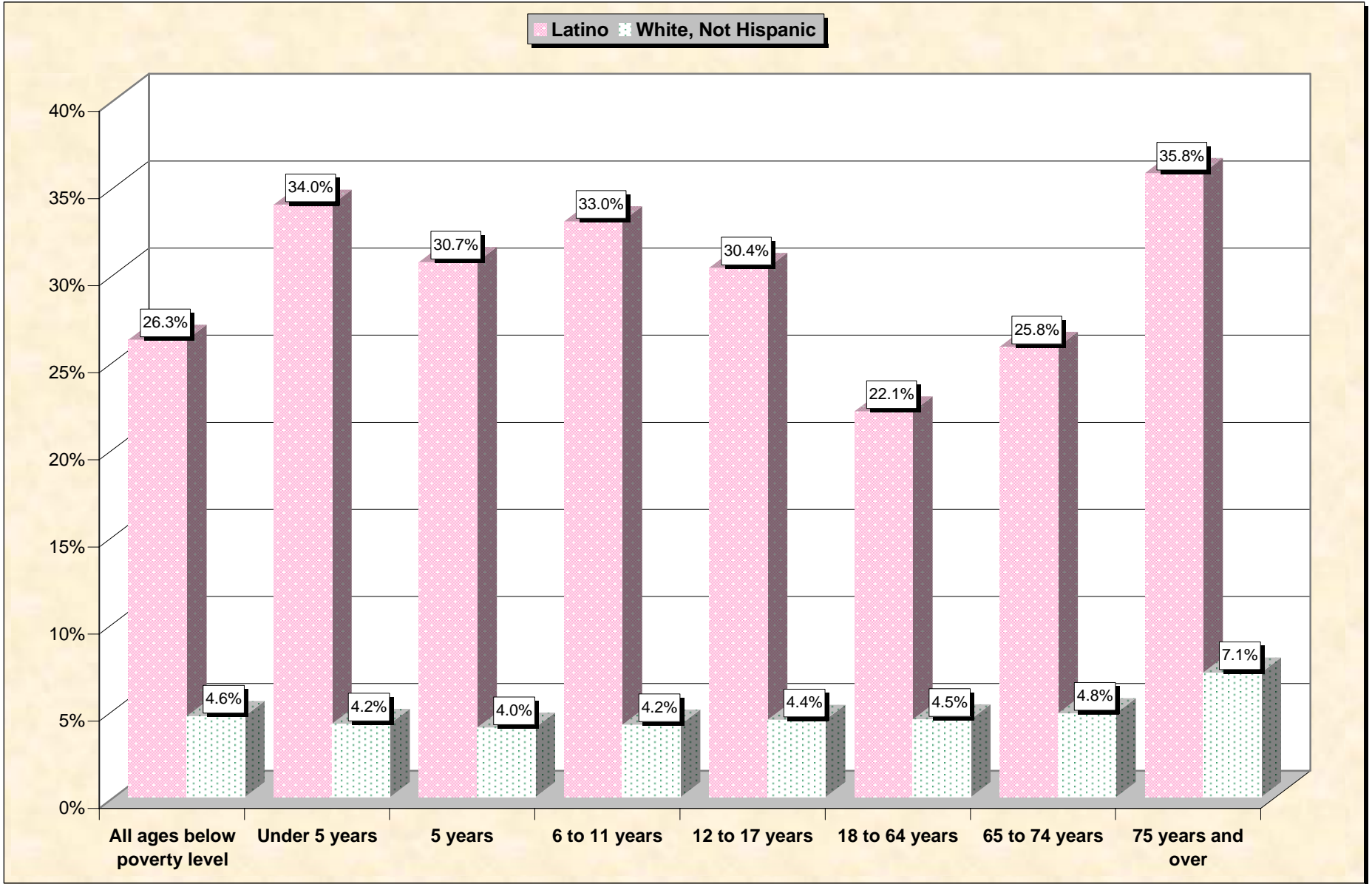
Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999

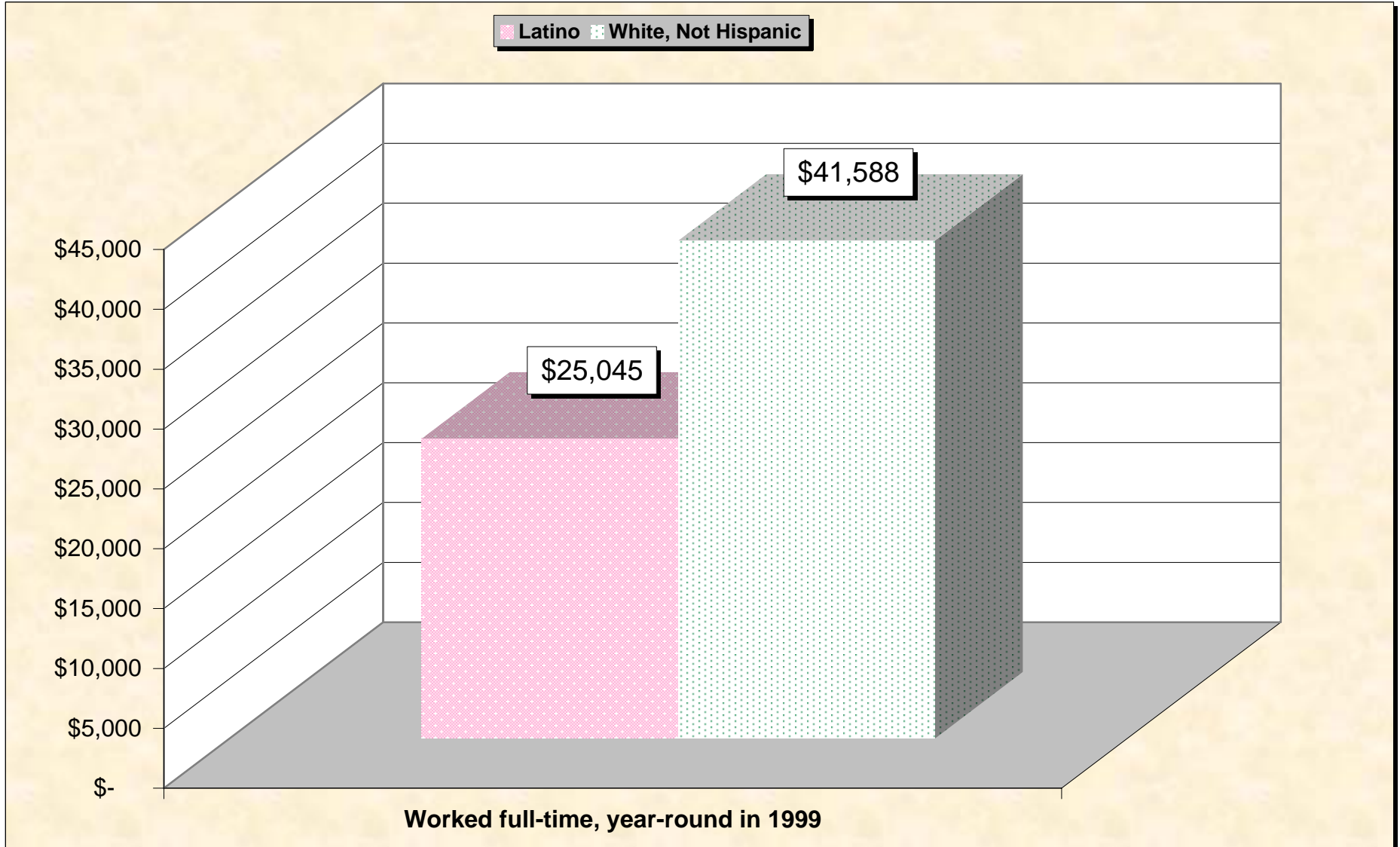
Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut

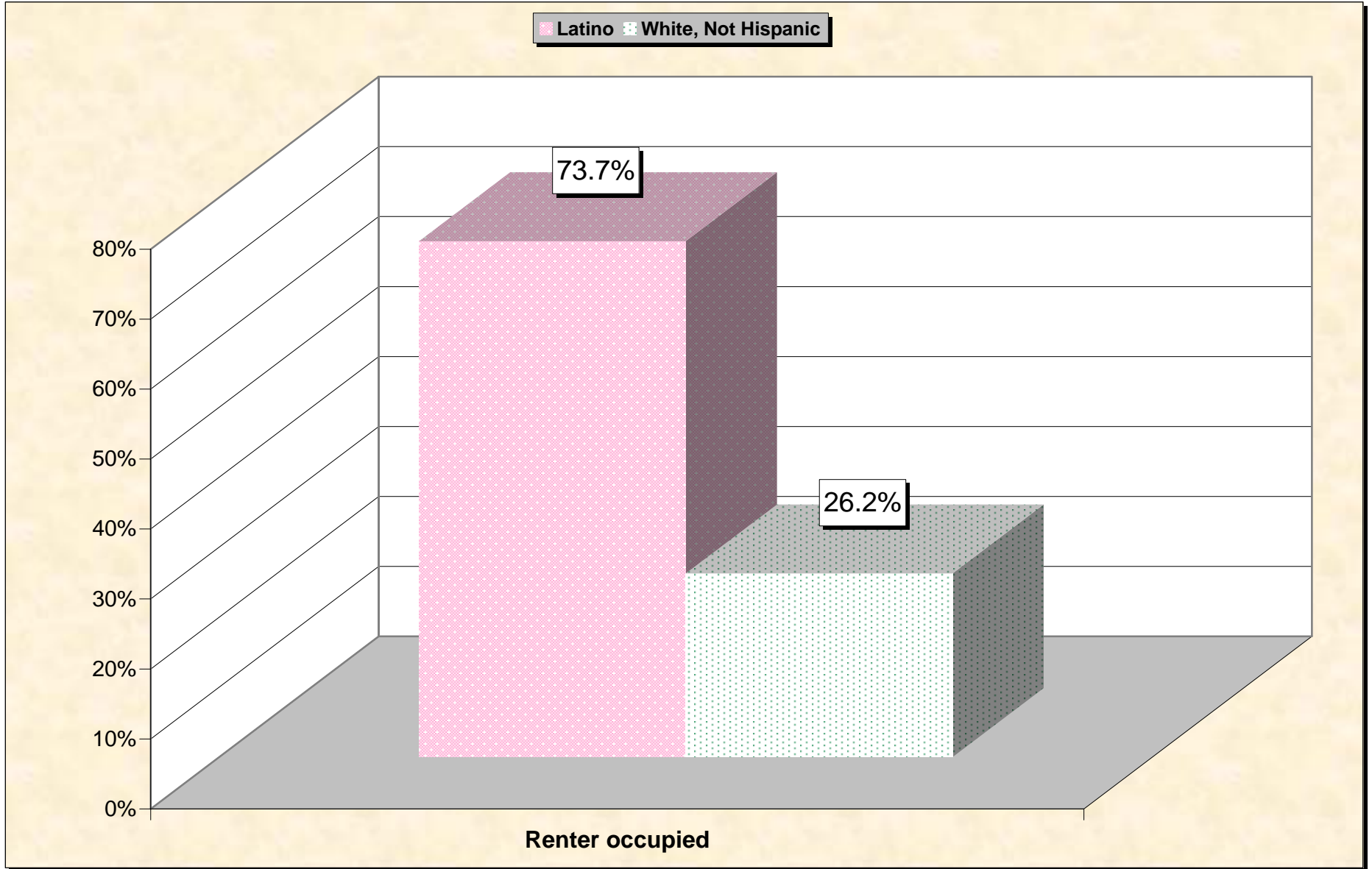
Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999

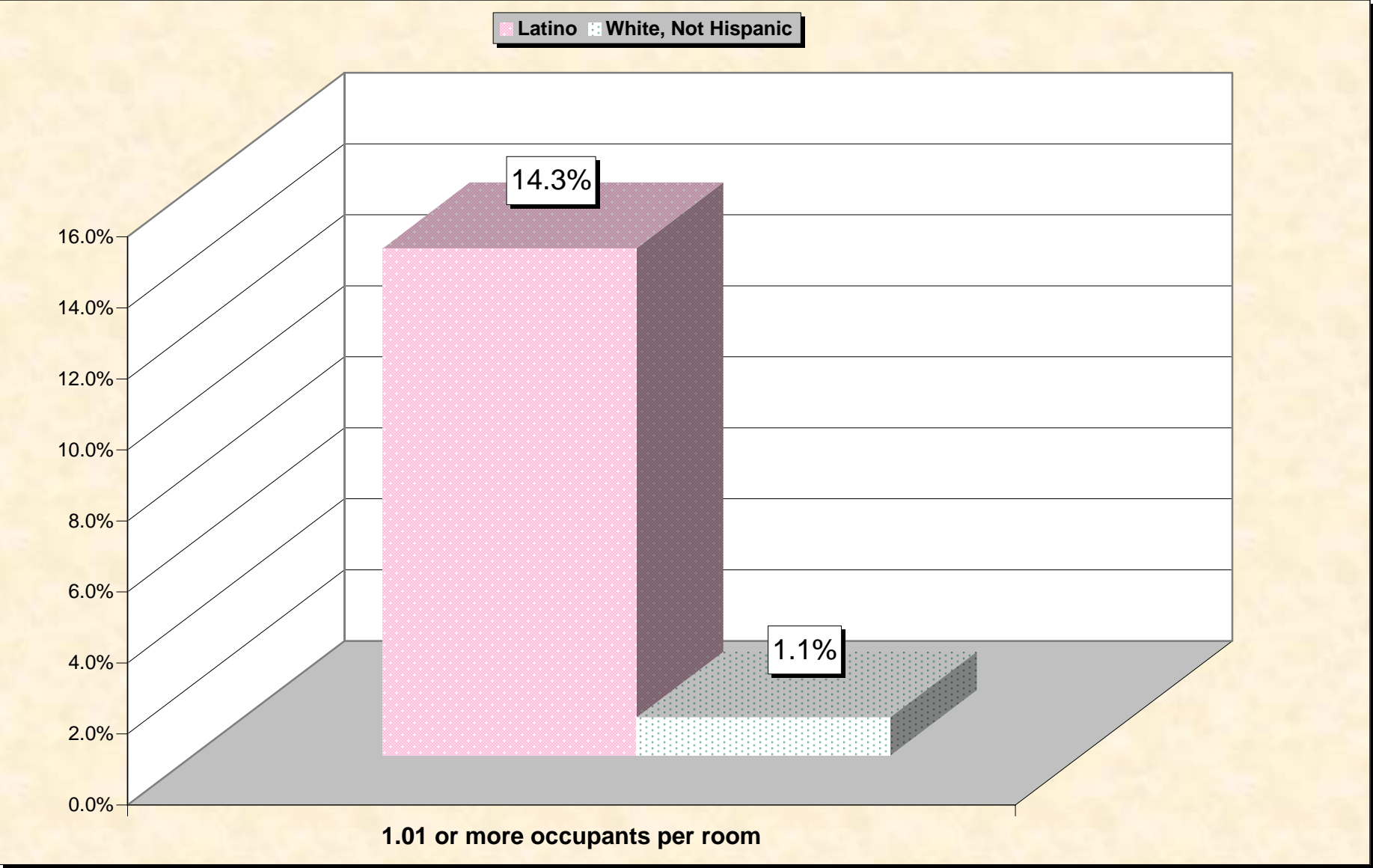

Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



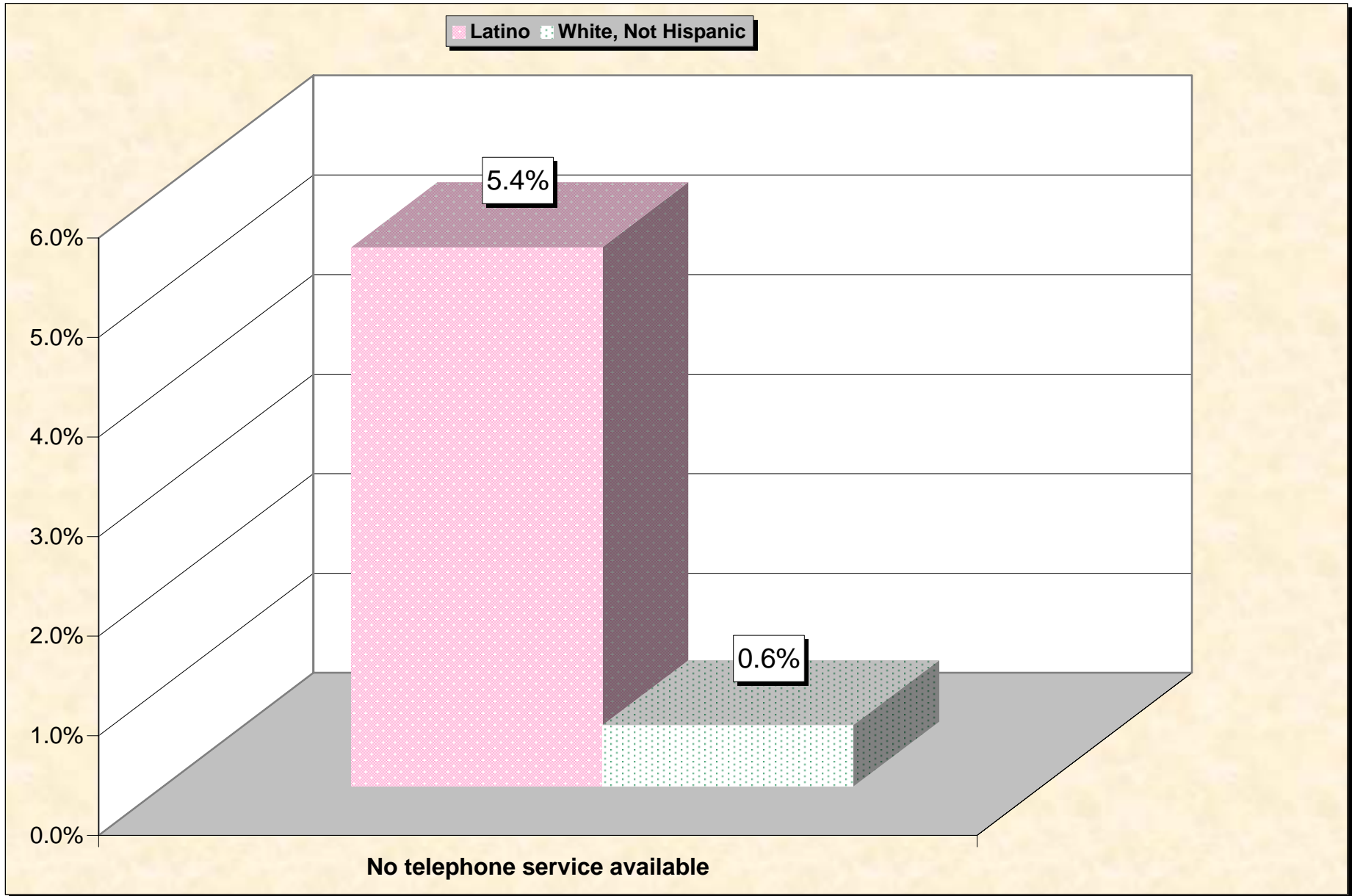

Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



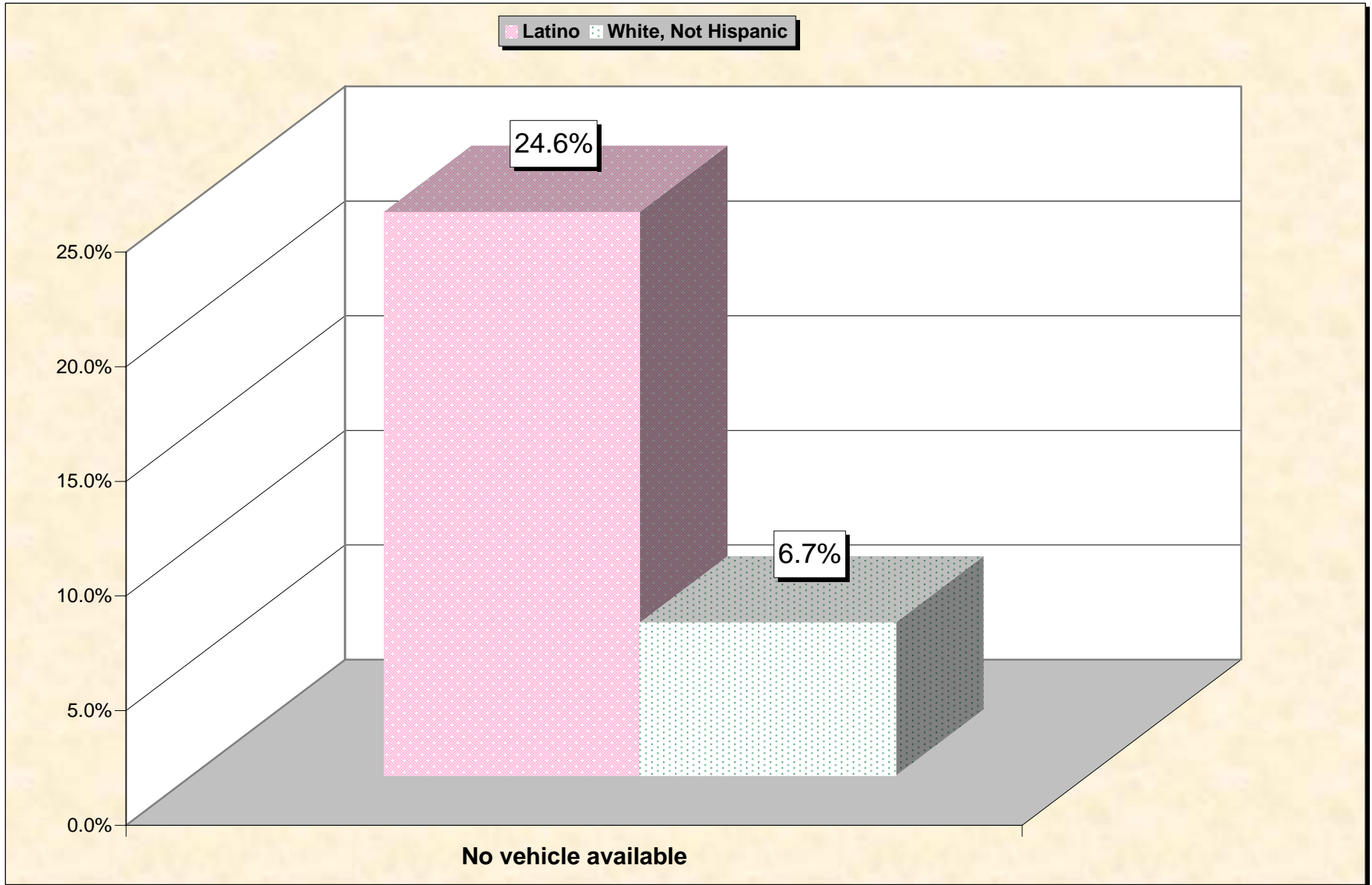

Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



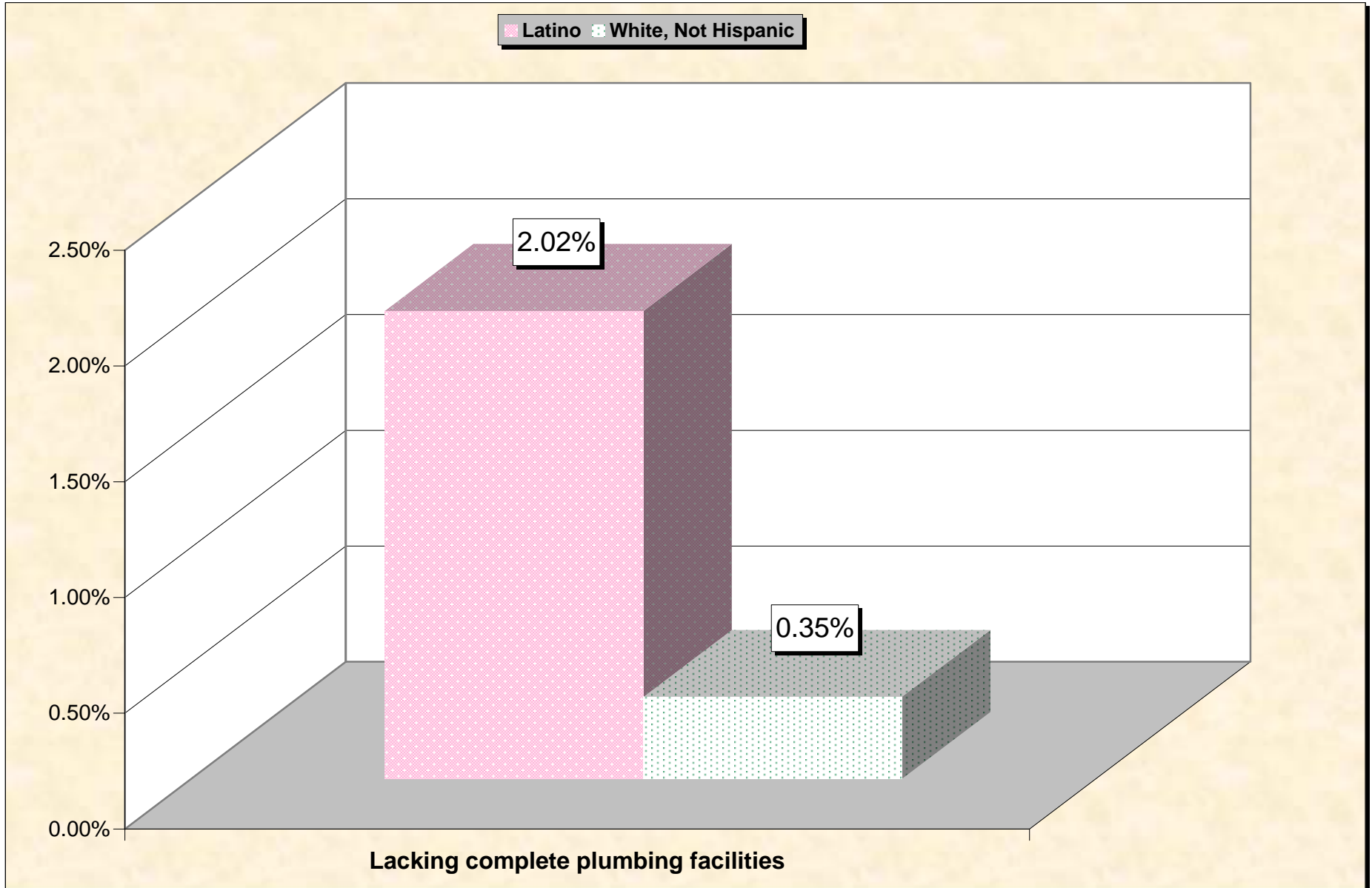

Chart 14 -- Lack of Vehicle By Household Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



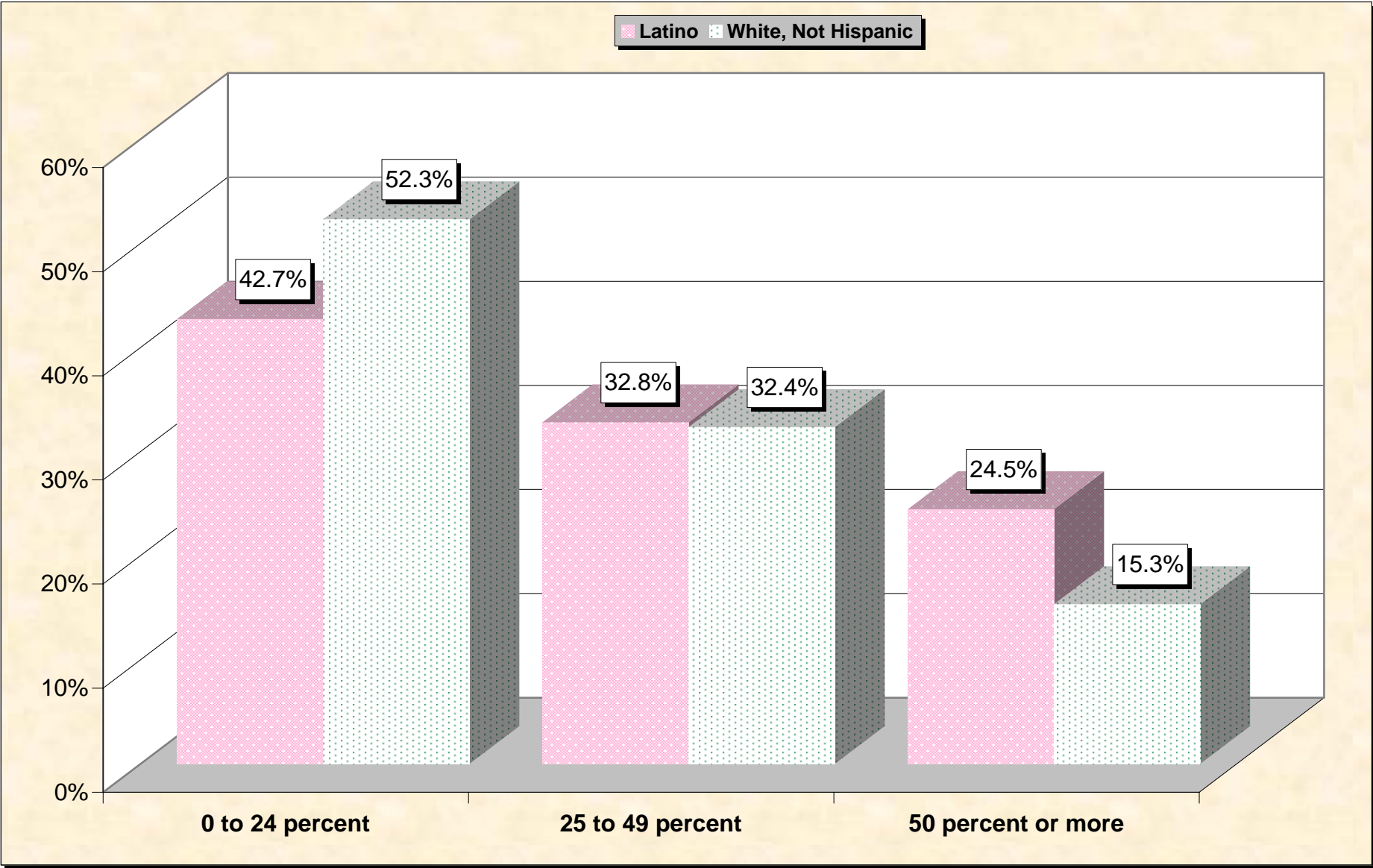

Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



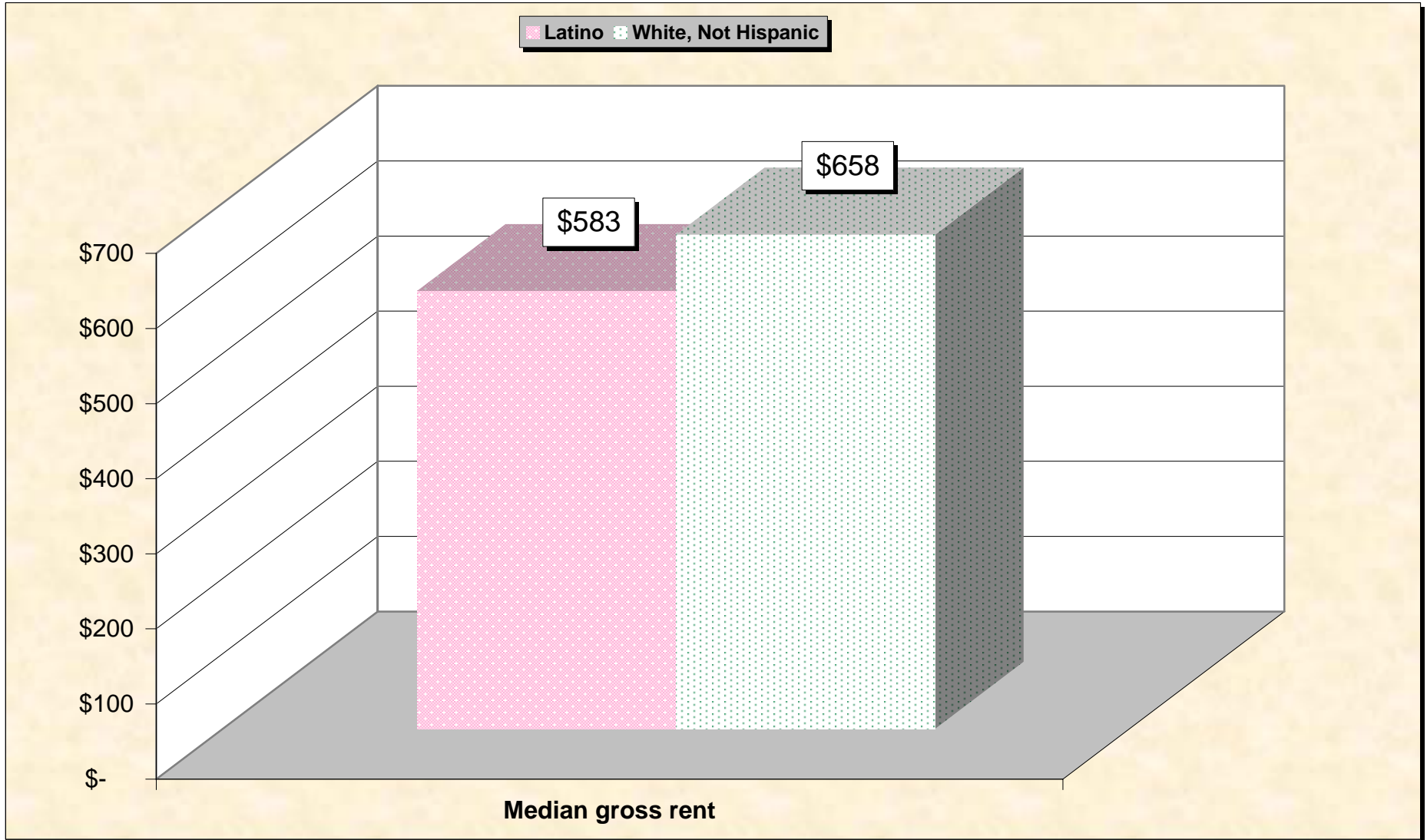

Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999 Congressional District 5 (108th Congress), Connecticut



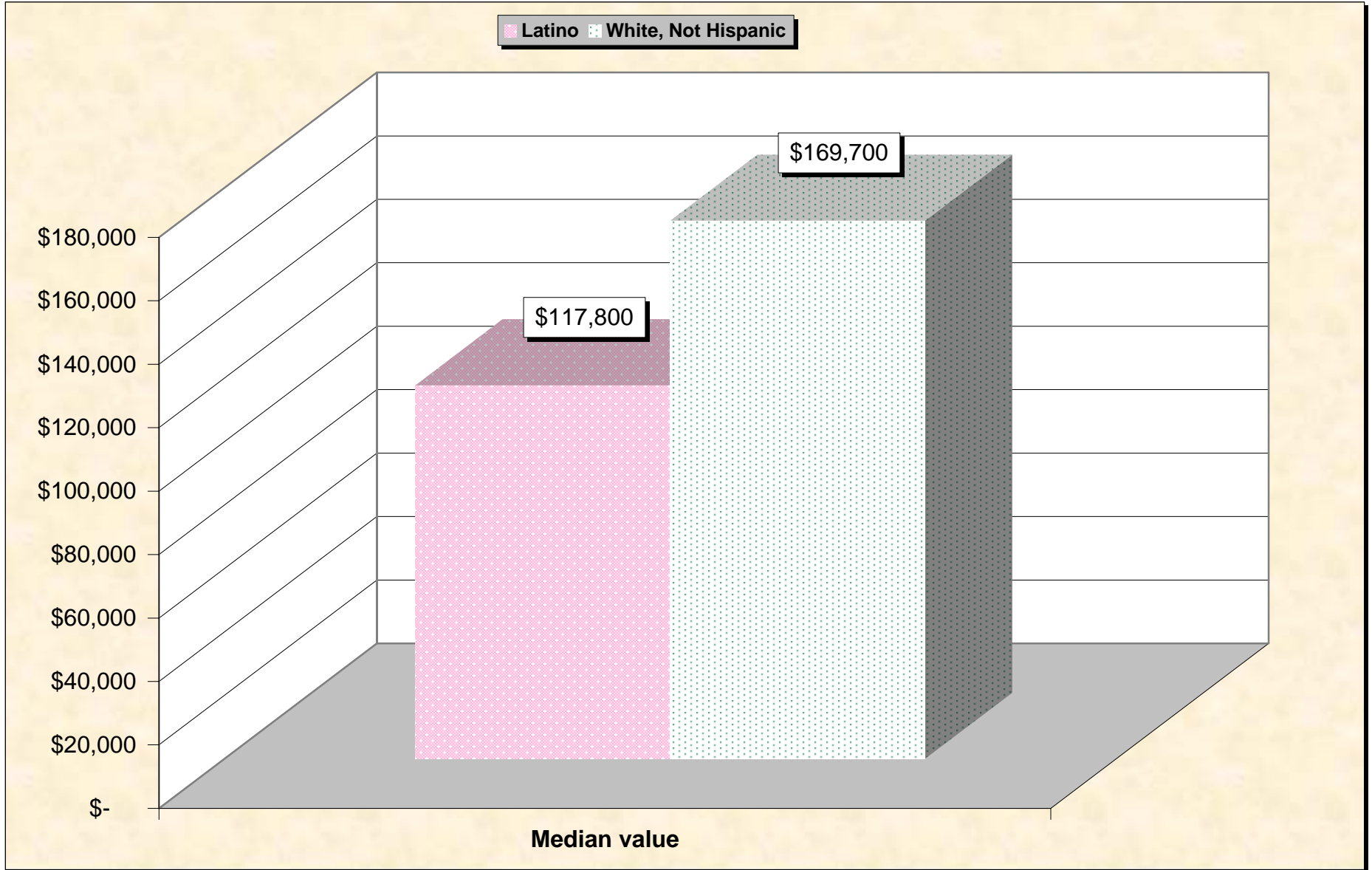
