

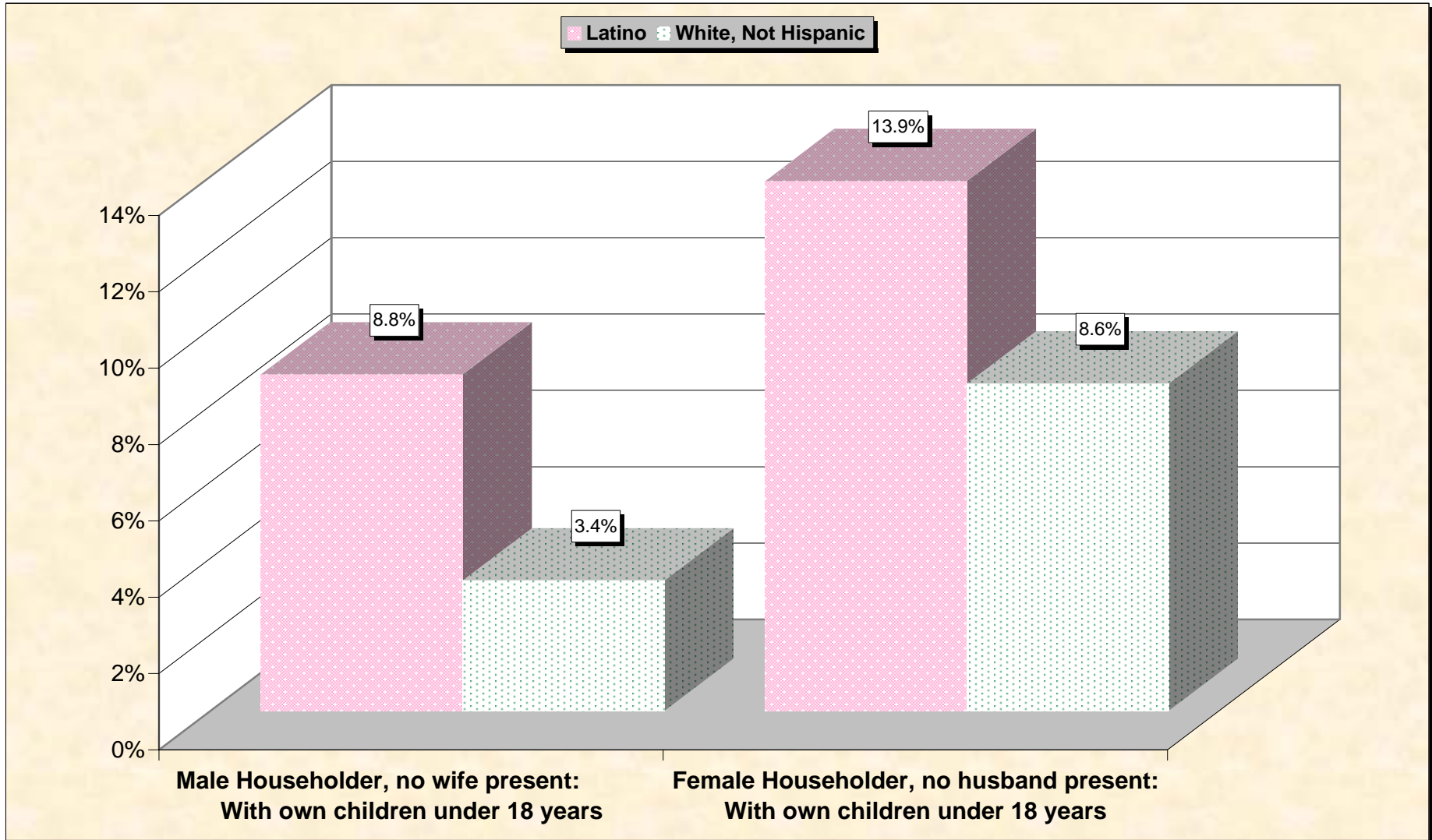

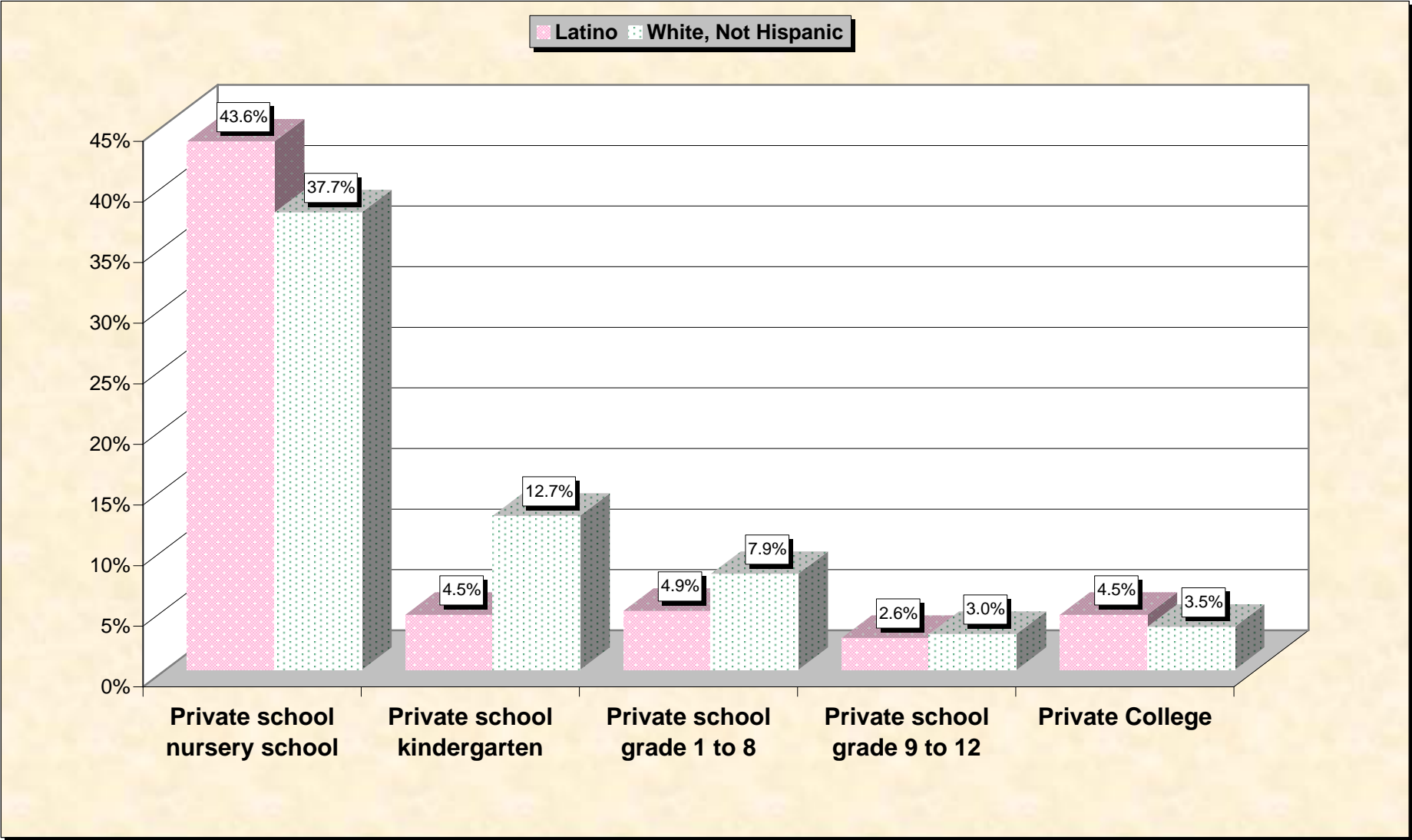

# Chart 1 -- Single-Parent Family Households (Householder 15 to 64 years) DeKalb County, Illinois



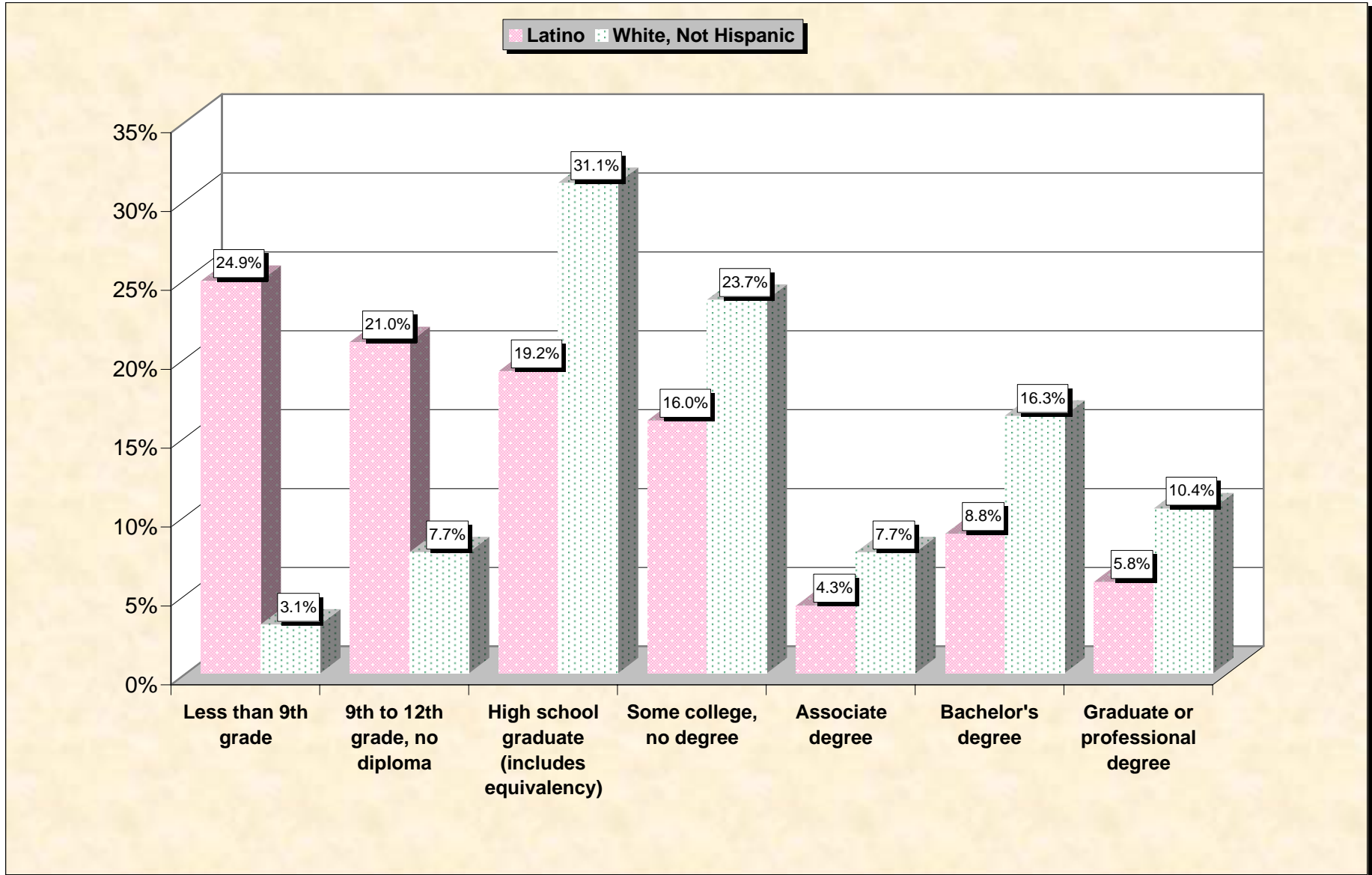

# Chart 2 -- Private School Enrollment (3 years and over) DeKalb County, Illinois



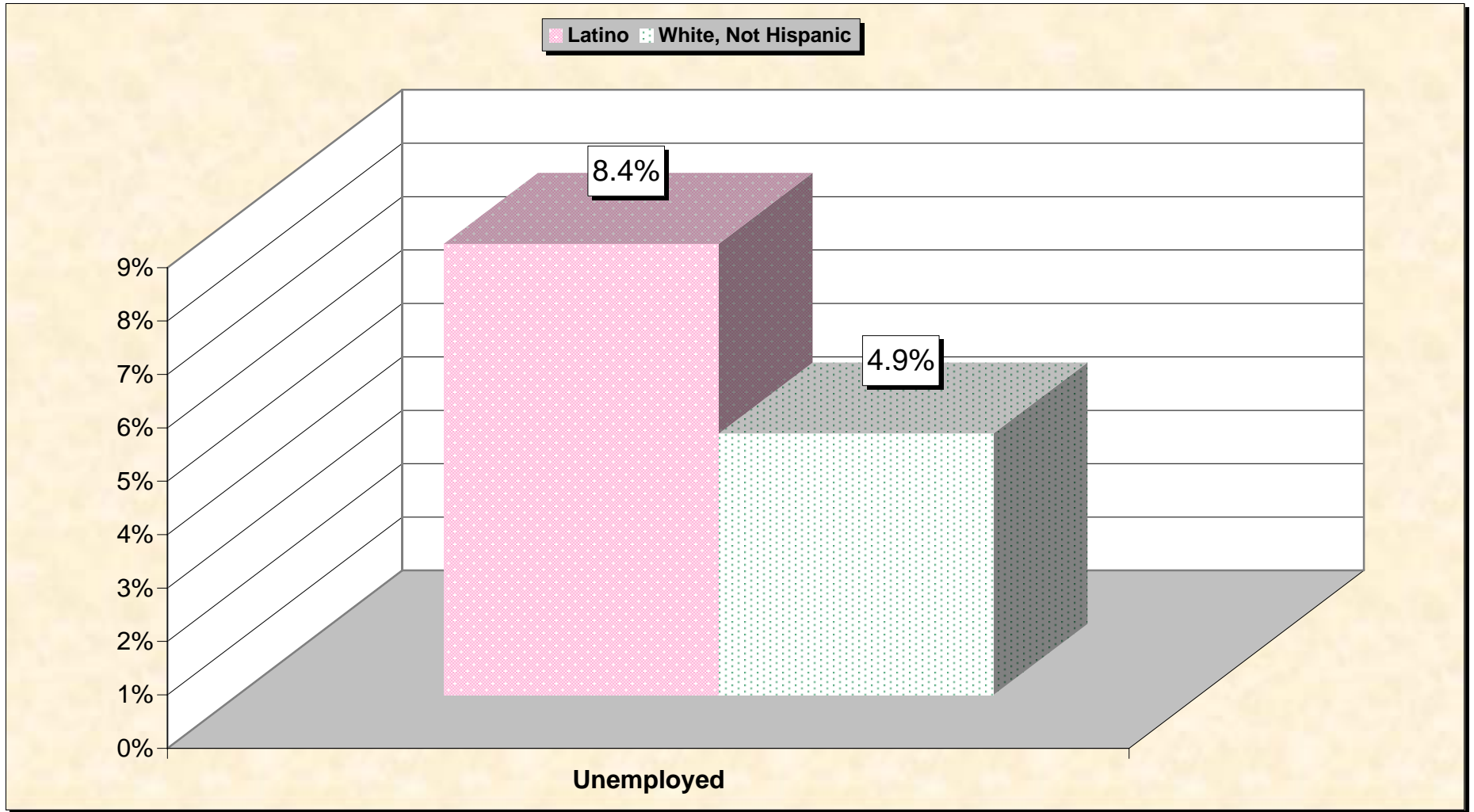

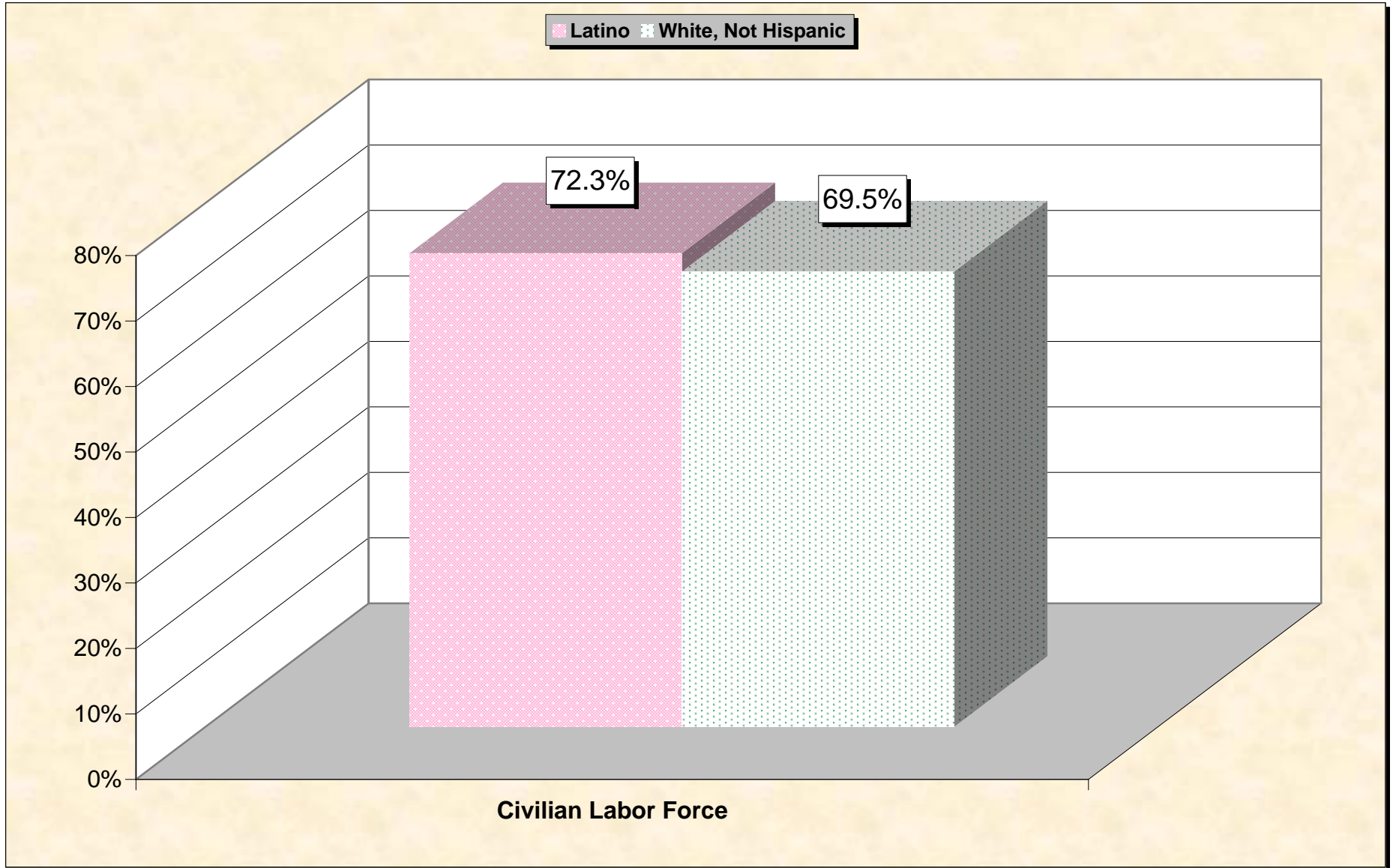
# Chart 4 -- Unemployment Rate (Civilian Labor Force) DeKalb County, Illinois

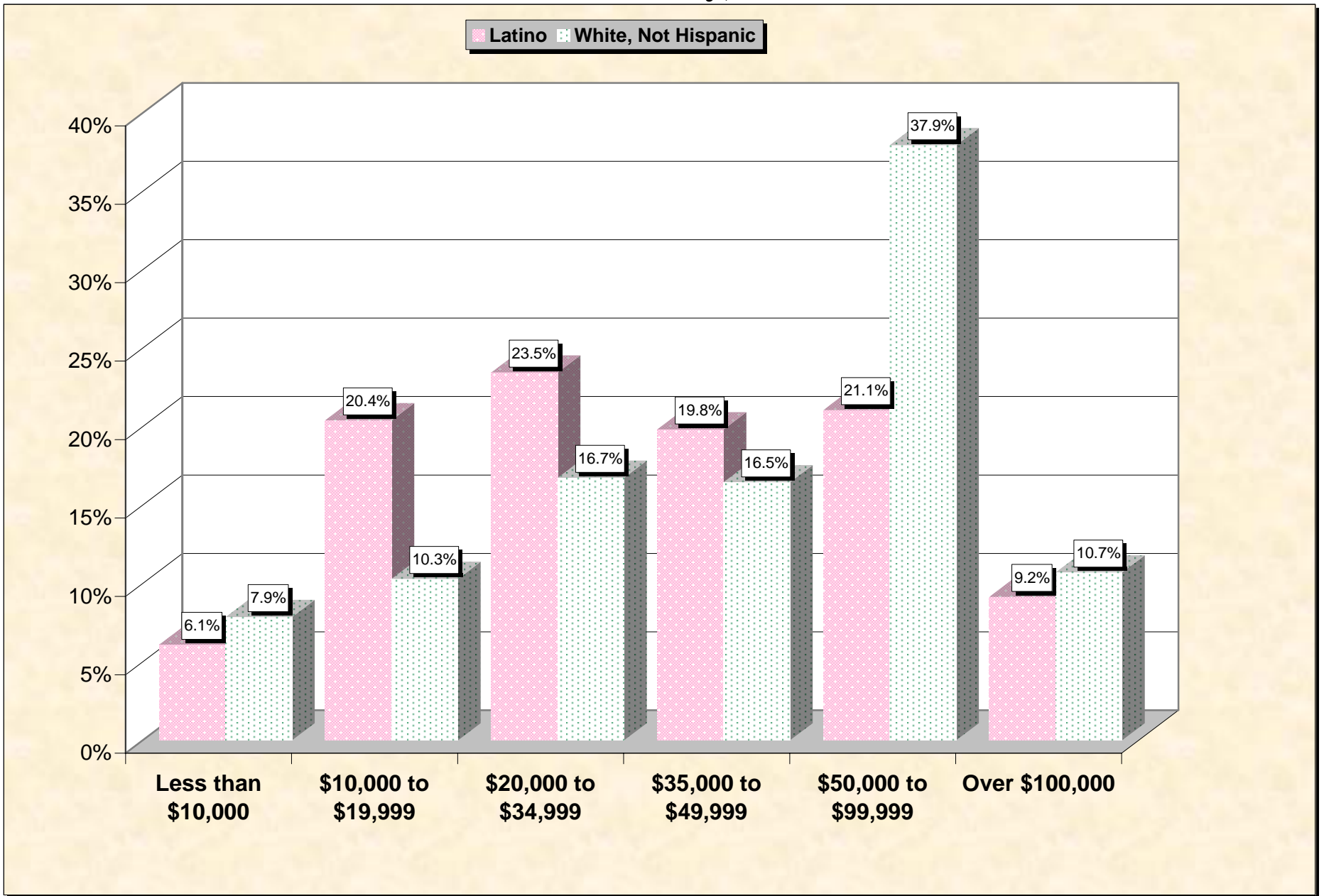
# Chart 5 -- Labor Force Participation (Civilian Labor Force) DeKalb County, Illinois

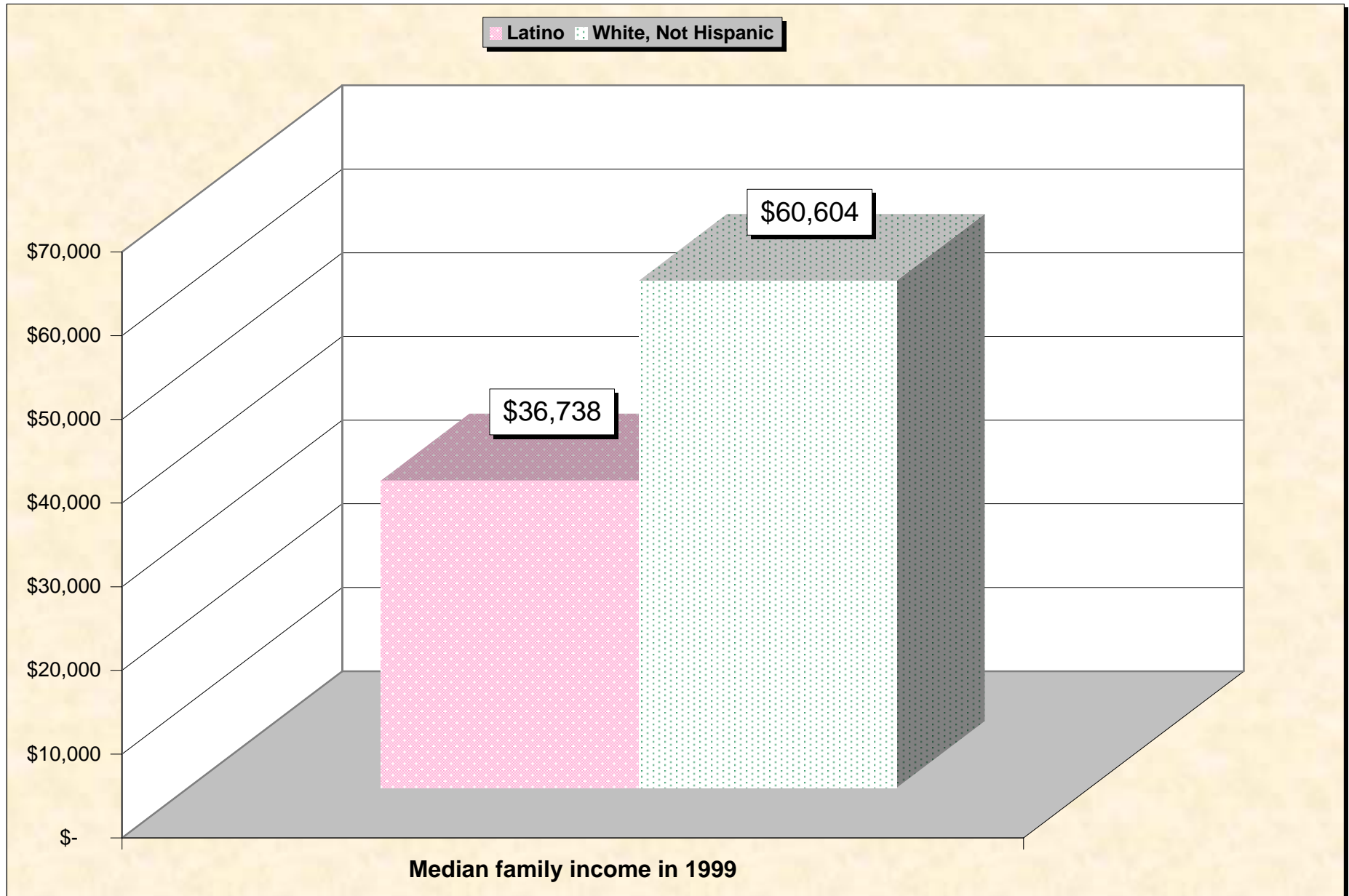

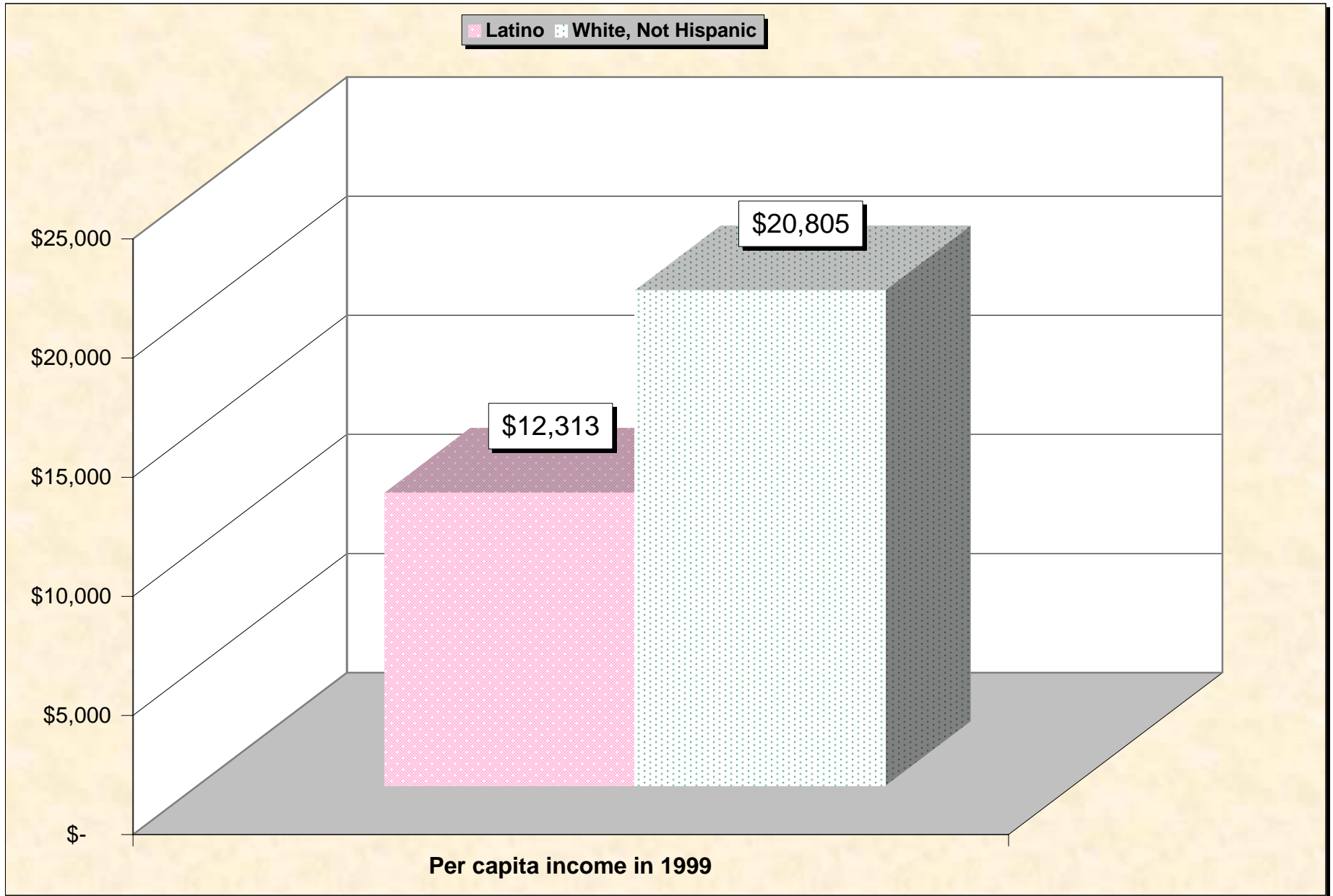
# Chart 7 -- Median Family Income In 1999 DeKalb County, Illinois

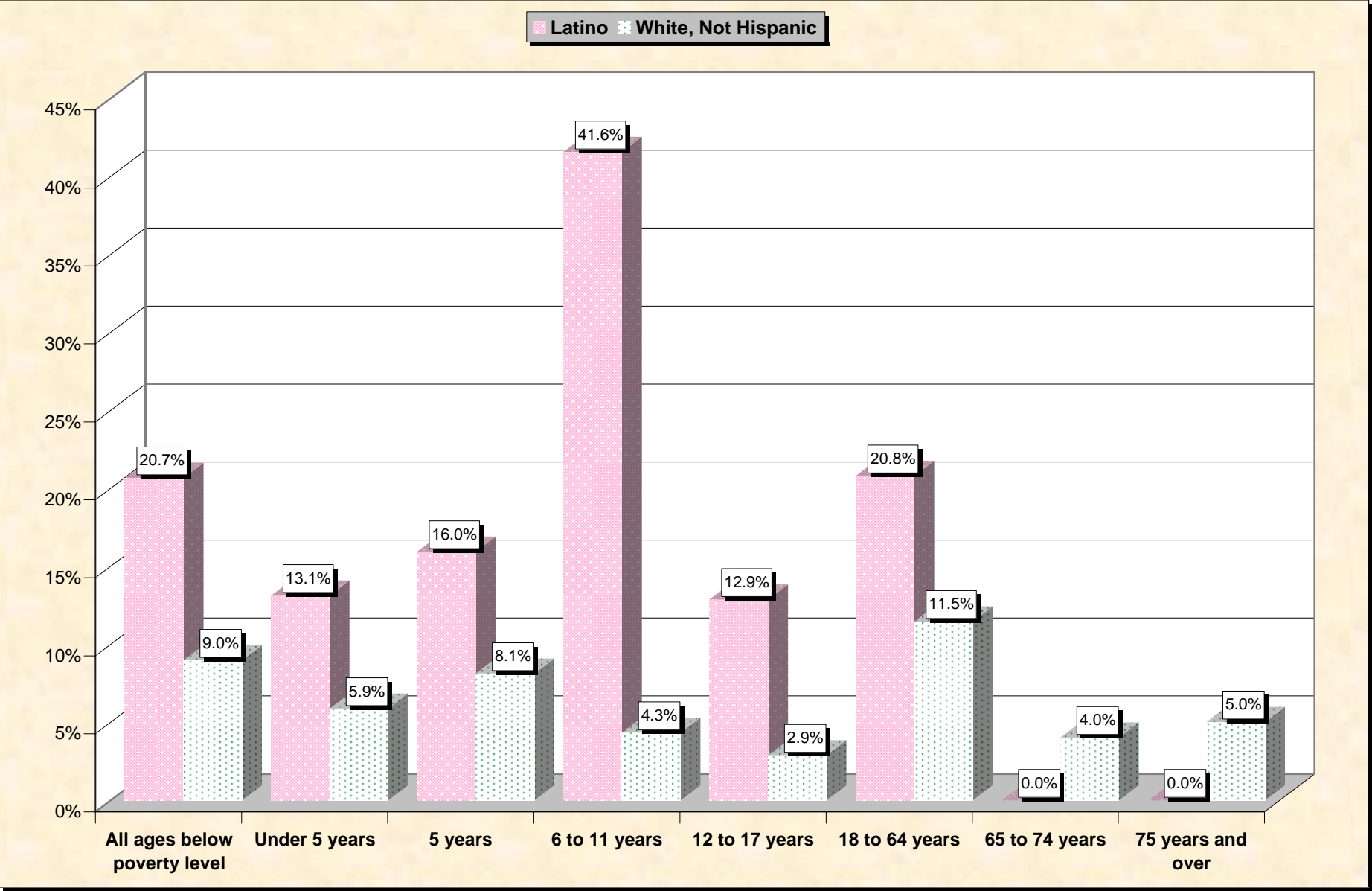


# Chart 8 -- Per Capita Income In 1999 DeKalb County, Illinois



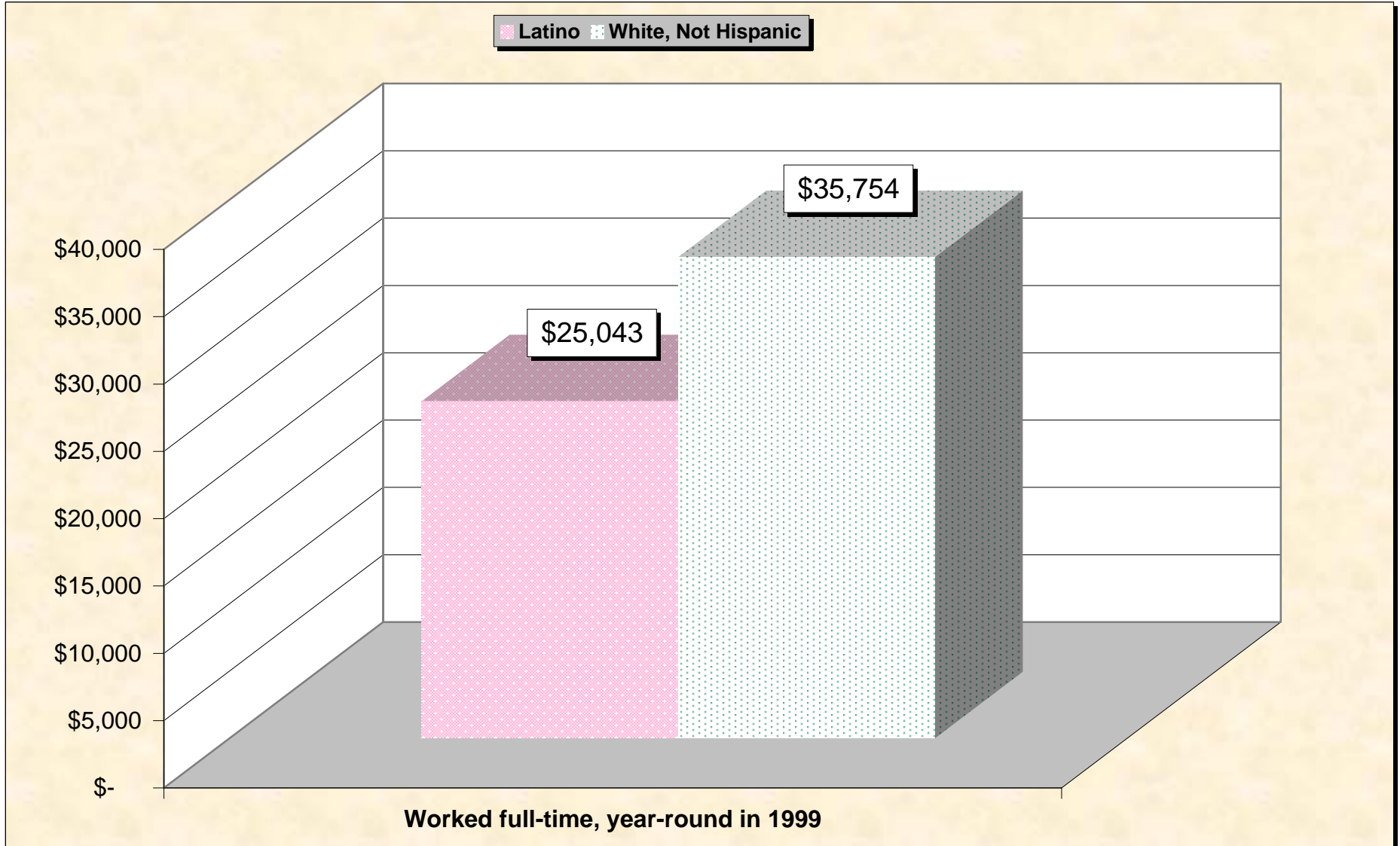

# Chart 9 -- Income in 1999 Below Poverty Level by Age DeKalb County, Illinois



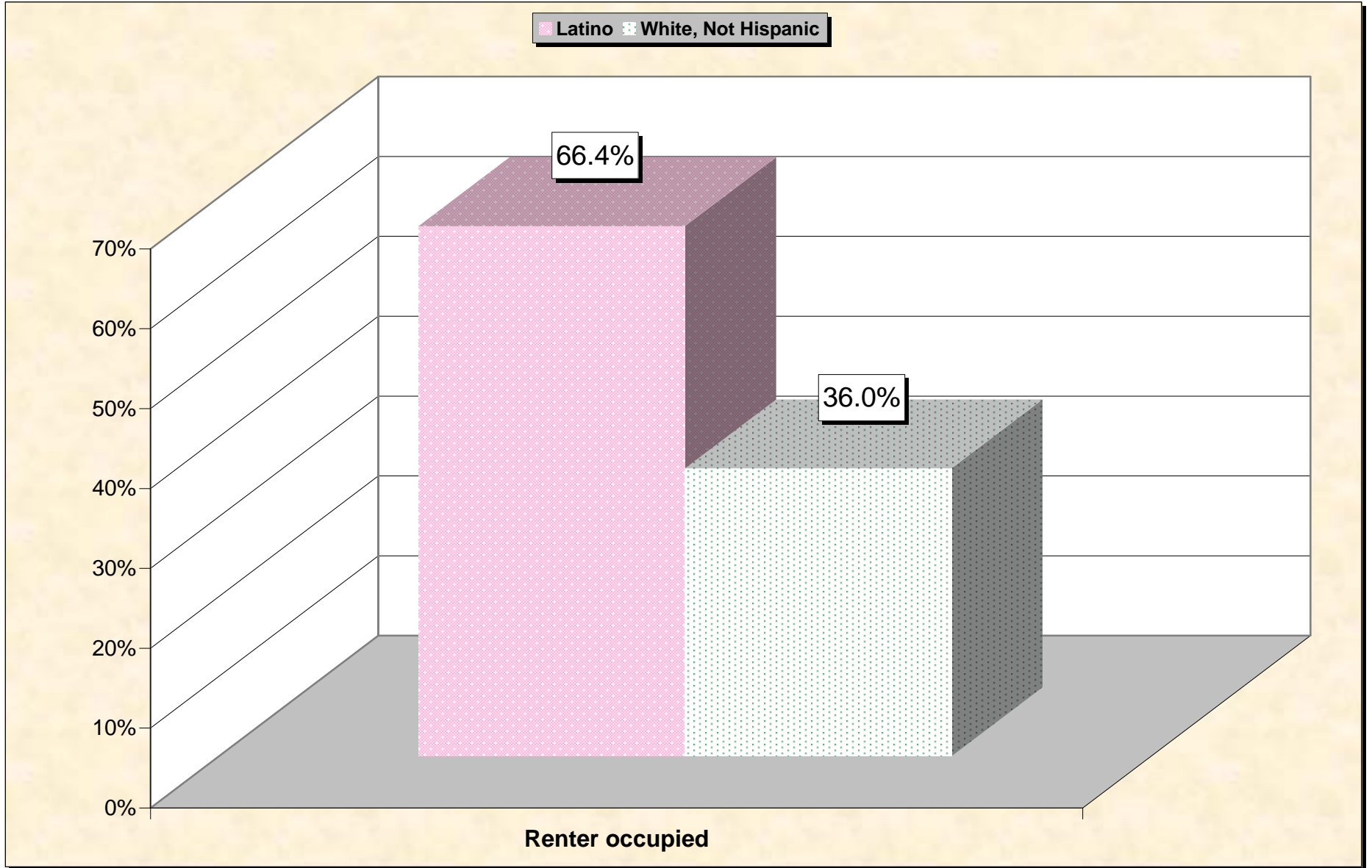

# Chart 10 -- Median Earnings in 1999 DeKalb County, Illinois



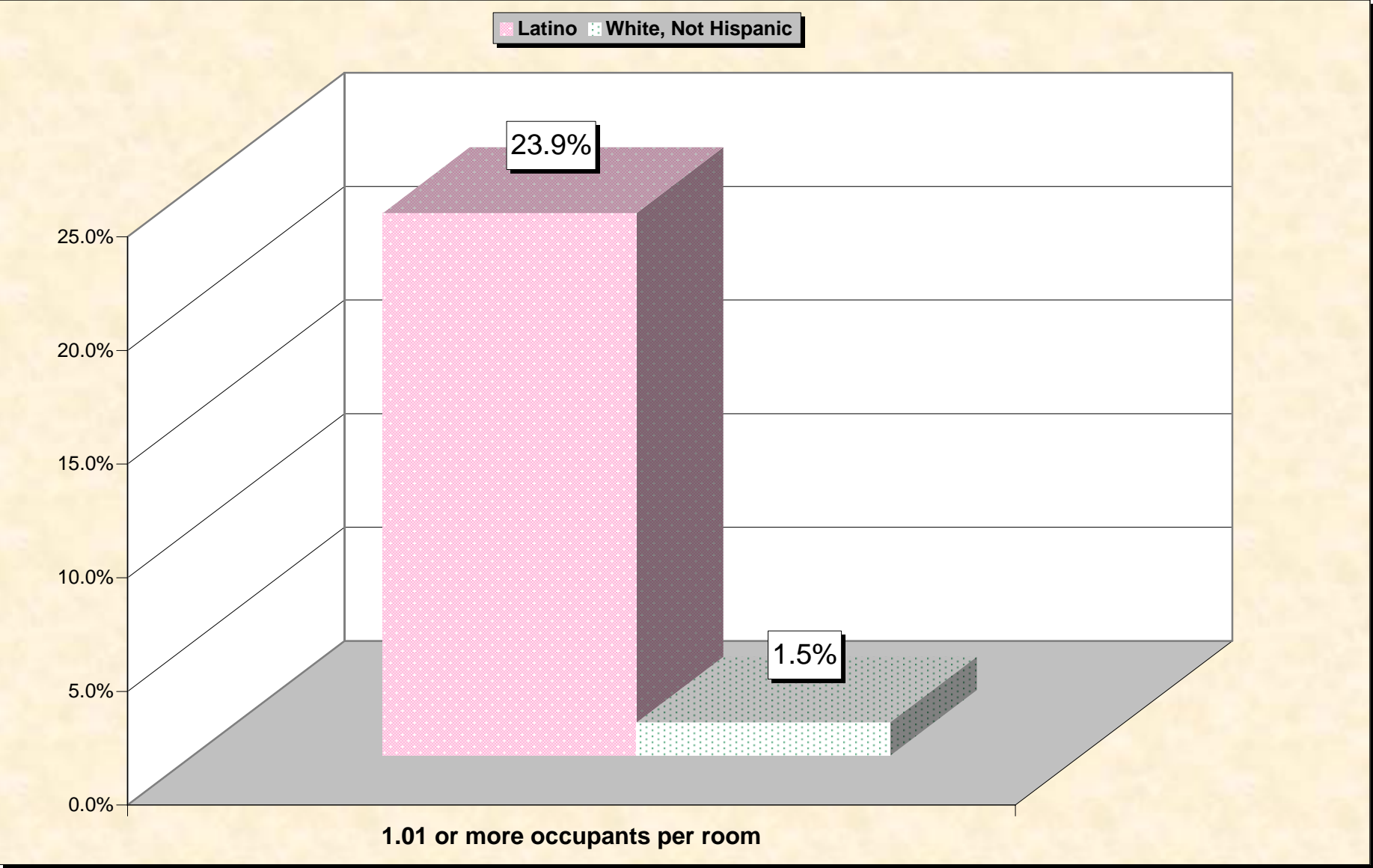

# Chart 11 -- Renter-Occupied Housing DeKalb County, Illinois



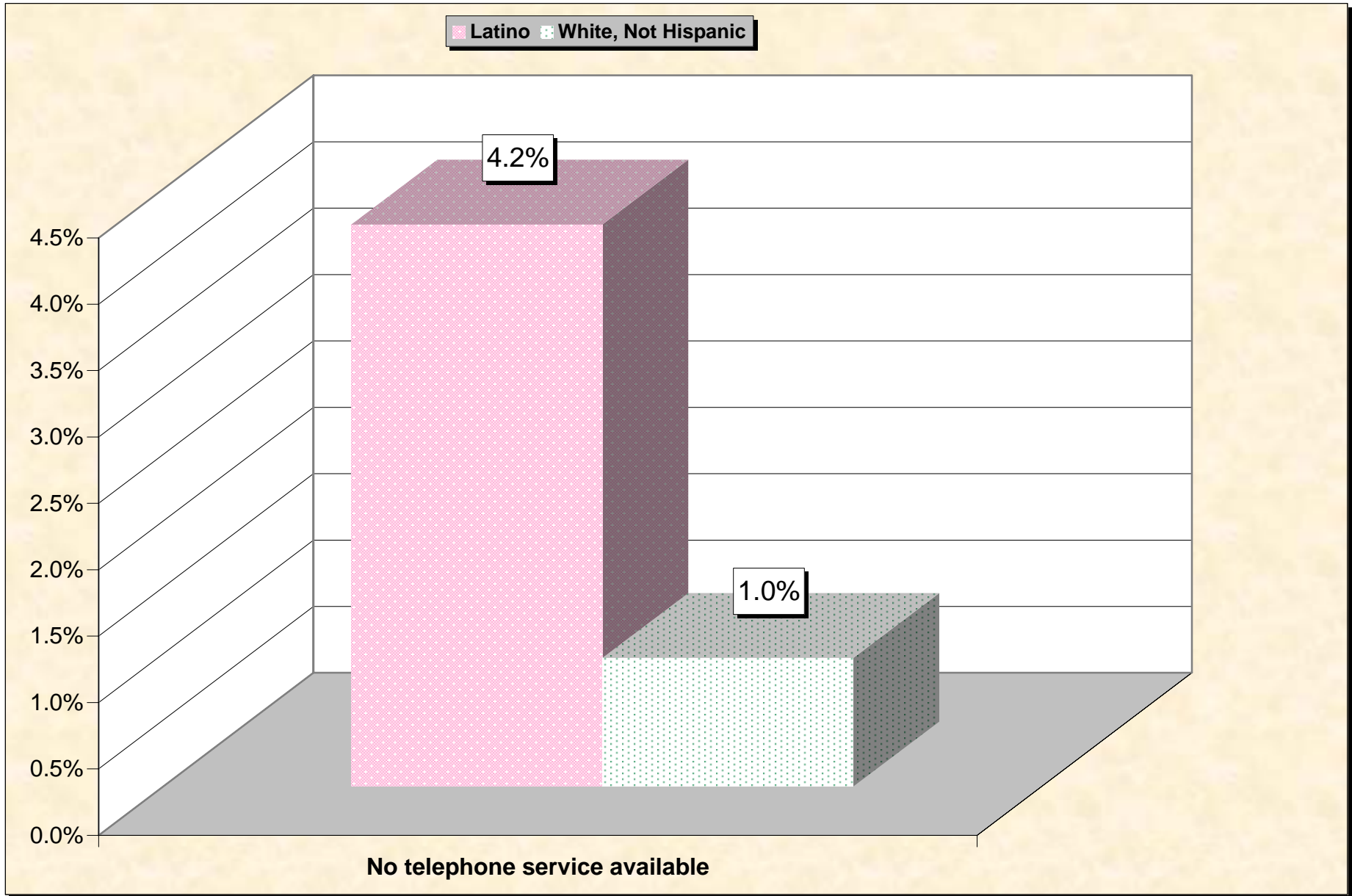

# Chart 12 -- Occupants Per Room (Crowding) by Household DeKalb County, Illinois



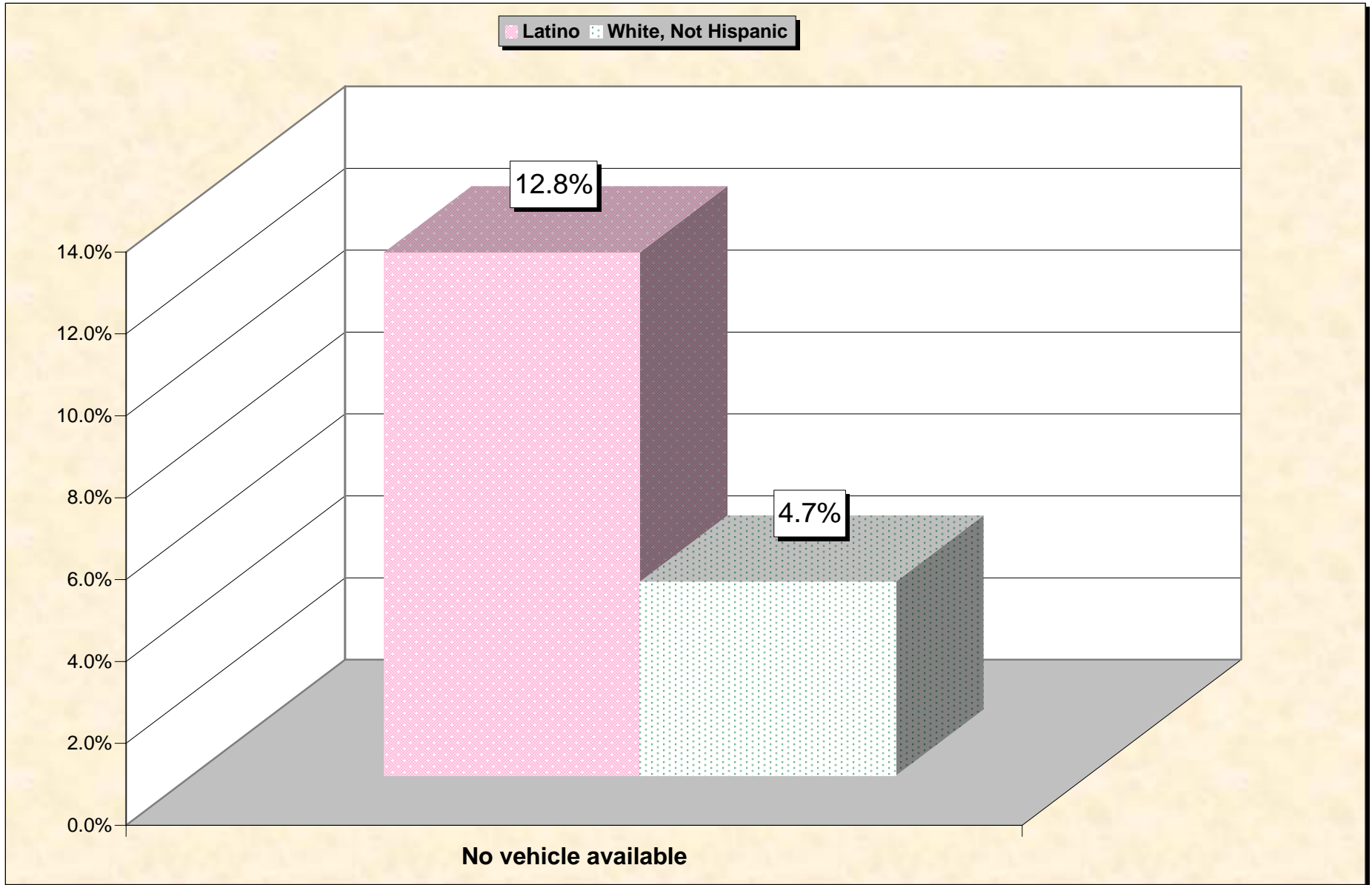

# Chart 13 -- Lack of Telephone Service by Household DeKalb County, Illinois



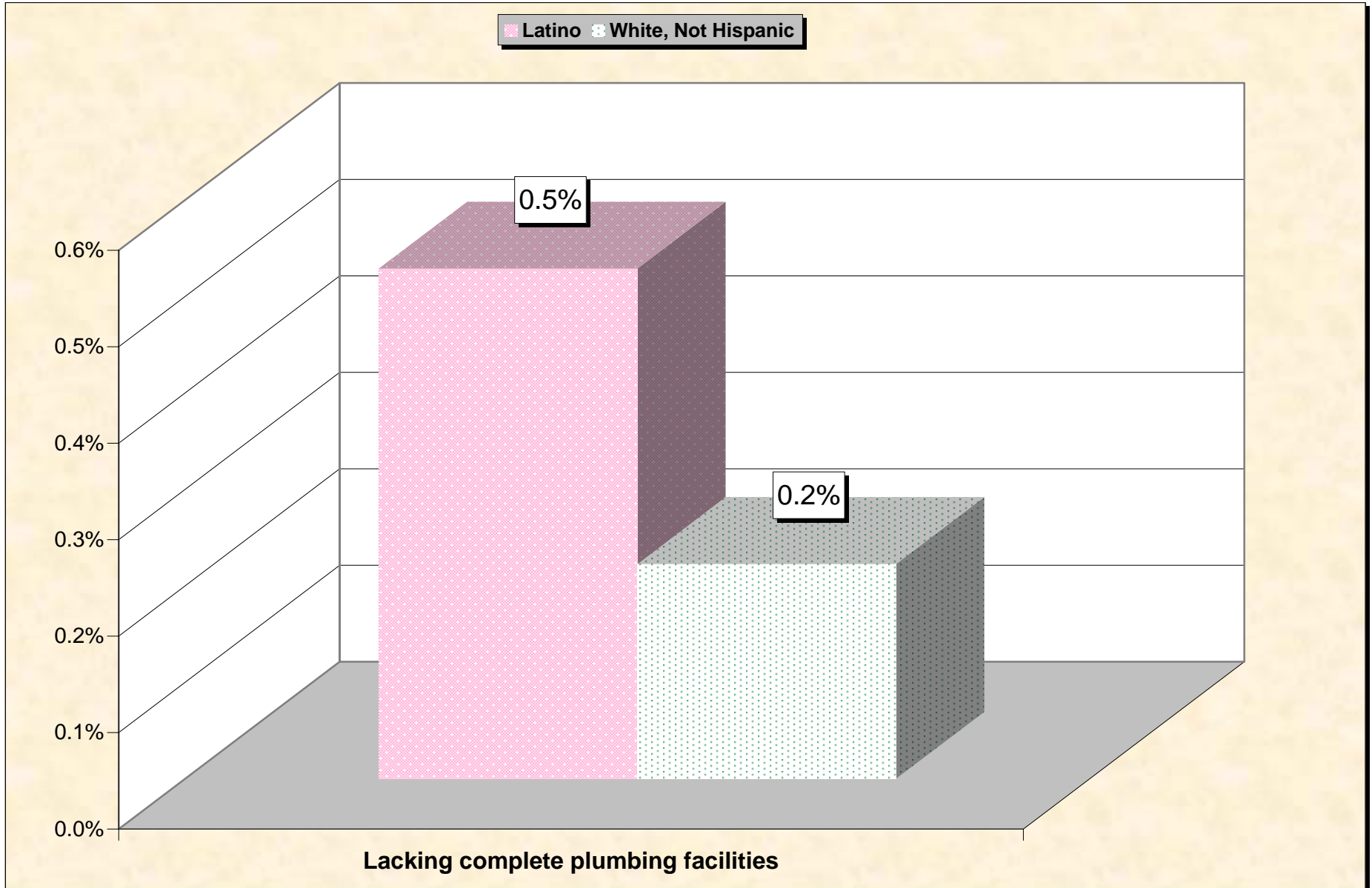

# Chart 15 -- Lack of Plumbing By Household DeKalb County, Illinois

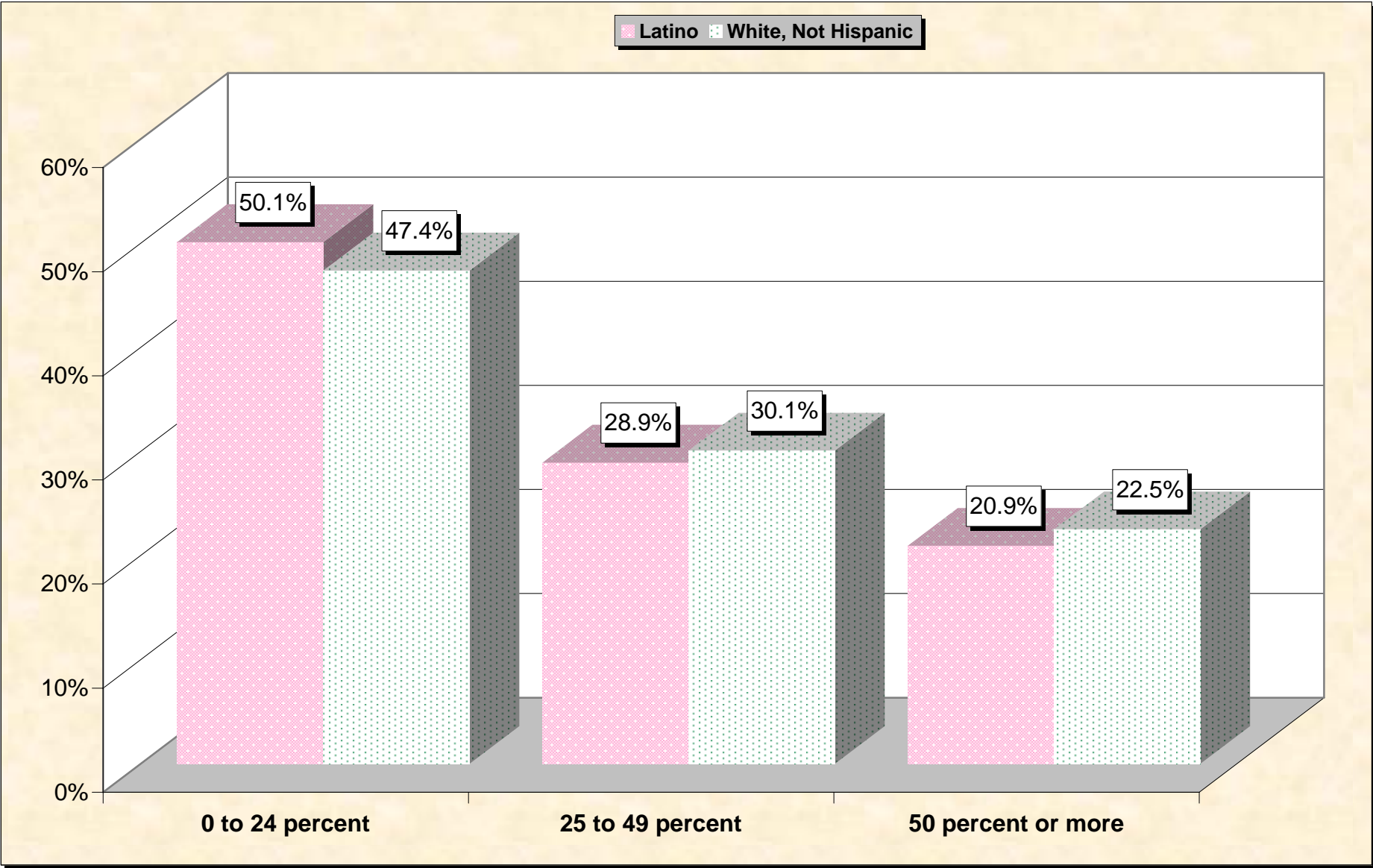

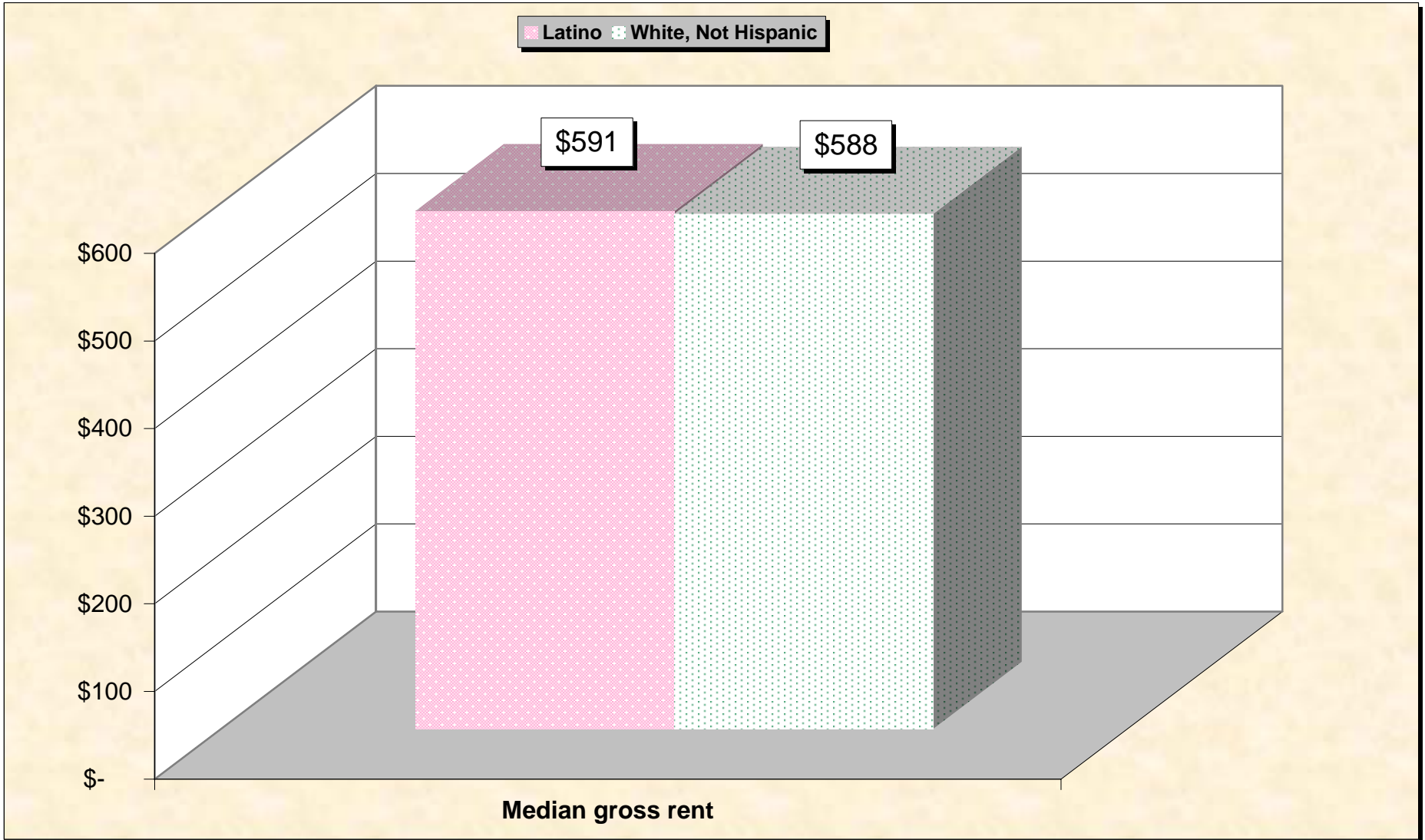
# Chart 16 -- Gross Rent as a Percentage of Household Income in 1999

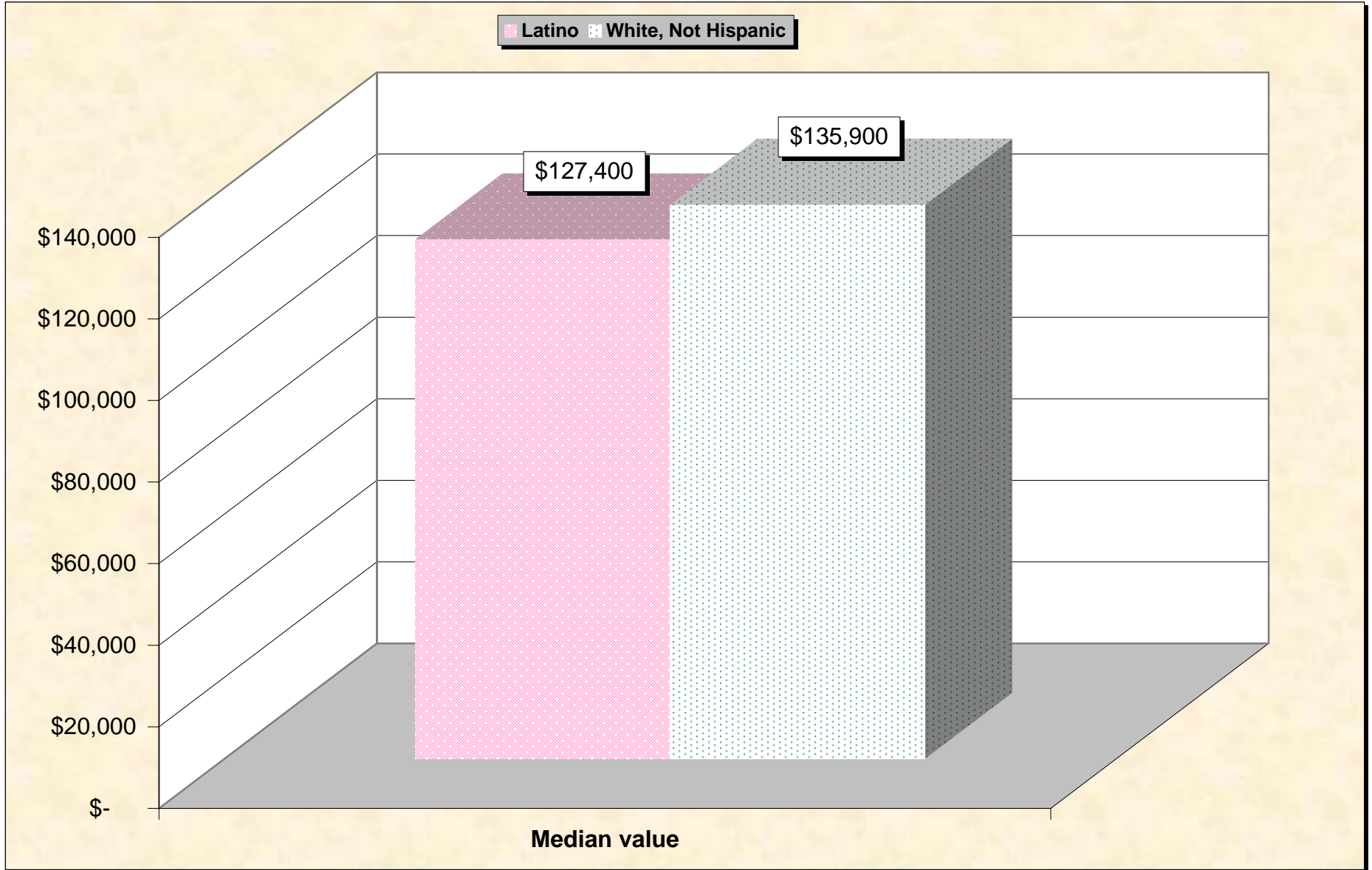
